



**REPORT OF THE
NCAA WOMEN'S GYMNASTICS COMMITTEE
FEB. 24, 2026, VIDEOCONFERENCE**

ACTION ITEMS.

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

1. **Welcome and announcements.** Staff welcomed committee members to the videoconference.
2. **Review potential amendment to Division I foreign tour legislation.** In preparation for the Cabinet's April 14-15 review of Proposal No. 2026-8 (Playing and Practice Seasons – Foreign Tour – Time Lapse Between Tours – Basketball – Once per Year), which would eliminate the once-in-four-years timing limitation and permit an institution to take a foreign tour once per year, the committee discussed whether the proposal should apply to Division I women's gymnastics teams. The committee supports the proposal applying to Division I women's gymnastics to continue uniform application of foreign tour legislation.
3. **Commercial logo placement discussion.** NCAA staff confirmed that the committee was still in support to formalize the commercial logo placements for women's gymnastics. At this time, the DI Cabinet has paused the progress of commercial logos on officials' uniform, and no action needs to be taken.
4. **Official scoresheet signature procedure.** The committee reviewed a document submitted by the rules interpreter for women's gymnastics and approved formalizing an allowance for the head coach to designate another individual to sign the official meet scoresheet in the event of an unavoidable absence by the head coach. NCAA staff will collaborate with the rules interpreter for women's gymnastics to formalize and publish this procedure moving forward.
5. **Championship updates.** NCAA staff provided updates regarding ongoing planning efforts with each of the four regional sites and national championship finals site.

Committee members confirmed their support of the procedure allowing participating coaches to receive judge assignments after arriving on-site at their regional location or final site.

6. **Future Meetings.** Committee and staff confirmed the schedule for upcoming meetings, including championship selections.
7. **Other items.** Committee members discussed at length waiver requests received to date related to the new NQS formula and, specifically, institutions hosting six home meets during the 2026 competition season. Following thorough discussion, the committee voted not to approve waivers allowing institutions to count all six home meets towards their NQS for championship selections.
