## INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

• Committee Composition. The committee approved the transition committee's recommendation regarding a three-way tie for the last success seat for the newly created oversight committee. This recommendation is to have the three conferences that tied fill the success seat and the two at-large seats and have all those terms match (August 2027). The committee also broke the tie in case that is needed for future use. The committee looked at the "points," particularly what the points would have been if the conference did not receive points for being in the opening round. The resulting order was the Patriot League, which did not have any teams in the opening-round games so no points were removed, with eight points; the Coastal Athletic Association with six points; and the America East Conference with five points.
