Championship Information.

2020 Championship. Will be combined and will be held at Lincoln Financial Field, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, May 24, 2020.

Pre-Championship Manual. Don't forget to go online and print the NCAA Division II Men's Lacrosse Pre-Championship Manual, which will be available online by **February 1, 2020** on NCAA.org.

Score Reporting. The score-reporting and stats-reporting processes are combined for Division II men's lacrosse. Schools will submit all schedule and results information to the NCAA statistics site (<http://web1.ncaa.org/stats/StatsSrv/login>), and this information will then be imported into the score-reporting system for use by the sports committees.

Selection of Participants for Division II.

[Reference: Executive Regulations Section and Bylaws 31.01, 31.02, 31.1, 31.2 and 31.3 in the NCAA Manual.]

Selection Requirements. To be considered for championship selection and rankings, a team must satisfy all scheduling requirements as outlined by championships policy in that sport and a team must

have an overall win-loss-record of .500 or better versus Division II opponents.

Selection Criteria:

The following criteria shall be employed by a governing sports committee in selecting participants for NCAA championships competition [*Bylaws 31.3.3; criteria for selection of participants and 31.3.3.1 criteria for selection in team sports*]:

- Availability of student-athletes for NCAA championships;
- Nullification;

Required Selection Criteria. Following confirmation of the availability of student-athletes for NCAA championships and the application of nullification, the following required selection criteria shall be applied in no particular order:

- In-region winning percentage;
- Division II winning percentage;
- Division II strength of schedule (opponents' average winning percentage and opponents' average winning percentage);
- Division II head-to-head competition; and
- Results versus Division II common opponents.

Sports-Specific Selection Criteria (in no particular order).

- Division II results versus teams with a winning record;
- In-region strength of schedule (opponents' average winning percentage and opponents' average winning percentage);
- In-region Ratings Percentage Index (RPI).

Additionally, input is provided by regional advisory committees for consideration by the Division II Men's Lacrosse Committee. A Division II governing sports committee must contact a regional advisory committee prior to making its final selection of teams if the committee selection differs from the regional advisory committees. Coaches' polls and/or any other outside polls or rankings are not used by the Division II Men's Lacrosse Committee for selection purposes.

Conference tournament games will be included for selections.

Bylaw 31.3.3.1.1 – Countable Competition.

For NCAA team-championship selection purposes, competition is countable only when the teams played are varsity intercollegiate teams of four-year, degree-granting institutions that conduct a majority of their competition in that team sport against varsity intercollegiate teams (see Constitution 3.3.4.4) of four-year, degree-granting institutions located in Canada and the United States, its territories or possessions. Competition against service teams, professional teams, semiprofessional teams, amateur teams, two-year colleges and club teams shall be excluded.

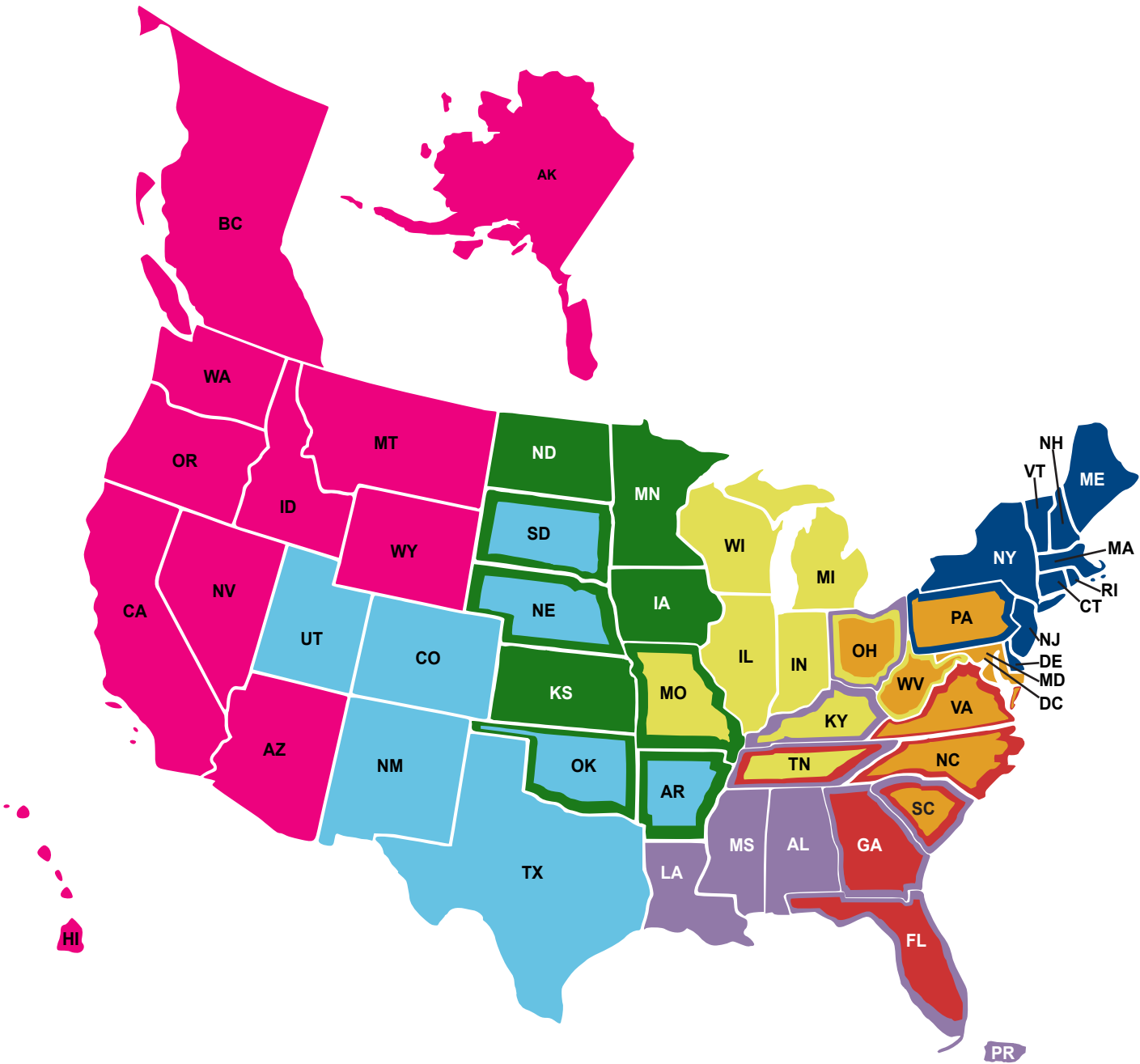
