INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

1. **February 12, 2025, report.** The committee discussed and approved the report from its February 12 meeting as submitted.
2. **Regional advisory committee.** Staff informed the committee of the regional advisory committee (RAC) orientation meeting on April 9. The committee was tasked with leading their RAC members through rankings calls in their appropriate regions starting in April. The committee also discussed how to properly and efficiently select potential site representatives for the 2025 Division II Men's Lacrosse Championship.
3. **Bracket expansion.** The committee continued discussing the possibilities of what an expanded bracket would mean for Division II men's lacrosse. The committee agreed that expanding the tournament, regardless of the number of teams being added, is positive for the sport and the championship.
4. **Other business.** Staff informed the committee of an email sent to the Division II conference commissioners detailing information regarding the 2025 Division II Men's Lacrosse Championship. Staff informed the committee that formal planning for the upcoming annual meeting in June has begun.
5. **Future meetings.** The committee was informed of a future meeting that will take place on March 20. Staff informed the committee that since bracket expansion is a committee priority, members must remain flexible to attend additional meetings to discuss important items or issues relating to the matter.
