1. **Welcome and announcements.** Kim Wayne, chair of the NCAA Women's Lacrosse Rules Committee, welcomed the committee.
2. **Review comment period results.** The Women's Lacrosse Rules Committee reviewed the results and feedback from the comment period. There was opposition to Rules 5-1, 6-14 and 6-3.b as it relates to 6v6 below the restraining line, and Rule 5-1 as it relates to 11v11. The Women's Lacrosse Rule Committee agreed additional discussion was necessary and rescinded these proposed rules changes. The Women's Lacrosse Rules Committee approved 6v6 to be an experimental rule during the nontraditional (fall) season.
3. **Review Collegiate Women's Lacrosse Officiating Association feedback.** The Women's Lacrosse Rules Committee reviewed the feedback from the CWLOA. The Women's Lacrosse Rules Committee noted the CWLOA had feedback on three proposed rules changes.
