

## Disclaimer on Interpretations for NCAA Rifle Competition.

The interpretations posted to <u>Rifle Rules of the Game</u> apply only to NCAA rifle competitions. NCAA rifle competition will continue to align as close as possible to what is required for USA Shooting matches and ISSF matches (e.g. world cups). To that extent, frequent communication is held between USAS and the ISSF. But even then, the two organizations can have differing opinions. NCAA rifle officials will continue to be educated on NCAA rifle competition rules updates to limit independent or misguided interpretations (e.g. competitors having to pry weights off the side of their rifle or completely re-adjust butt plates).
