 - Minimum contest and participants requirements.
 - a. Recommendation. That an institution must meet the rowing minimum contests and participants requirements for sport sponsorship to be eligible to be selected to the Division II Women's Rowing Championships.
 - b. Effective date. September 1, 2019.
 - c. Rationale. The Division II Management Council and Division II Championships Committee directed that championship participation minimums should match sport sponsorship minimums. Staff will work with the results reporting vendor to determine if it can create an automated process to check this information. If the vendor is unable to meet this request, committee members will have to check each institution's team schedule and results or have the institutions attest to sponsorship.

The committee will continue to review the individual event requirements for ranking and selections.
