INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

- **Division I Men's Soccer 21st Century Model.** The NCAA Division I Men's Soccer Committee has reviewed the materials relating to the proposed 21st century model and supports the concepts specific to Division I men's soccer. Accordingly, the committee supports adoption of Proposal No. 2019-90 regarding the 21st Century Model for Men's Soccer. After reviewing the materials on <https://www.21stcenturymodel.org> and through multiple discussions, the committee feels that the model will positively enhance NCAA Division I men's soccer and the overall experience of the NCAA Division I Men's Soccer Championship for all participants.

The Division I Men's Soccer Committee acknowledges challenges to such a significant redistribution of the men's soccer season on each individual campus but based its decision to support the model on (1) what is best for NCAA Division I men's soccer and (2) what is best for the student athletes. After considering all of the factors, the primacy of the men's soccer student-athlete experience convinced the Division I Men's Soccer Committee that the 21st Century Model best positions a successful future for the sport.
