

REPORT OF THE NCAA DIVISION I WOMEN'S SOCCER OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE OCTOBER 27, 2025, VIRTUAL MEETING

ACTION ITEMS.

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

- 1. Squad size/roster limits. The NCAA Division I Women's Soccer Oversight Committee took action to increase the championship squad size from 22 student-athletes to 28 student-athletes. This increase is effective beginning with the 2025 NCAA Division I Women's Soccer Championship and does not increase the travel party number which remains at 28.
- 2. U.S. Soccer NextGen presentation. The Women's Soccer Oversight Committee received a presentation from U.S. Soccer on the October 16, 2025, white paper published by the NextGen College Soccer Committee, that outlines recommendations to advance Division I women's soccer.
- 3. Intercollegiate Women's Soccer Organization for Coaches survey. The Women's Soccer Oversight Committee received an update from the United Soccer Coaches regarding the results of the 2025 NCAA Division I Women's College Coaches Survey which included feedback on potential legislative changes in Division I women's soccer.
- **4. Other business.** The Women's Soccer Oversight Committee was notified that information regarding future meeting dates and the cadence of meetings will be shared at a future date.
