

## REPORT OF THE NCAA DIVISION II MEN'S AND WOMEN'S SOCCER COMMITTEES MARCH 5, 2024, VIDEOCONFERENCE

## KEY ITEMS.

• 2025 championship. The committee is recommending that the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference host the 2025 Division II Men's and Women's Soccer Championships. (See Nonlegislative Item.)

## ACTION ITEMS.

- 1. Legislative items.
  - None.
- 2. Nonlegislative items.
  - 2025 championship host.
    - (1) <u>Recommendation</u>. That the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference host the 2025 soccer championships at Switchbacks FC Stadium, in Colorado Springs, Colorado.
    - (2) Effective date. Immediate.
    - (3) <u>Rationale</u>. The 2025 championships were to be conducted in Matthew, North Carolina; however, with Chattanooga removing their bid for 2024, the committees chose to move Matthews from 2025 to 2024. The committees then had staff contact past hosts who had submitted bids for the current bid cycle. Multiple hosts expressed interest in hosting, and after reviewing the options, the committees voted to move the championship to Colorado Springs.
    - (4) Estimated budget impact. None.
    - (5) <u>Student-athlete impact</u>. This change will ensure providing the best student-athlete experience possible. Given the RMAC's past hosting experience and their demonstrated eagerness to host again, the committees are confident they will do the same for participating teams in 2025.
