



## 2023-24 Men's and Women's Soccer Rules Results

### Methods

- This is a survey of conference commissioners, conference coordinators, directors of athletics, head coaches, officials, and senior woman administrators regarding possible rule changes. Participants were also asked to provide the Soccer Rules Committee with any feedback regarding the proposed rule changes.
- The survey was designed to take no more than 10-minutes and was administered online through the QuestionPro survey software.
- The survey was open from November 1 to November 30, 2023.
- The survey was distributed to 6,367 participants with 2,178 responses (34 percent response rate).
