

2024-25 Softball Rules - Survey Results

Methods

- This was a survey of head coaches, directors of athletics, senior woman administrators, conference commissioners, conference coordinators of officials and umpires. The purpose was to gather feedback on behalf of the Softball Rules Committee on proposed rules changes for the next two years (2026 and 2027).
- The survey was designed to take no more than 10 minutes and was administered online through the Qualtrics survey software.
- The survey was open from April 1 to April 30, 2025.
- The survey was distributed via email to coaches, umpires and conference coordinators of officials. The survey link was posted to an online survey dashboard webpage designed for athletics directors, senior woman administrators and conference commissioners to provide rules survey feedback during the 2024-25 academic year. A notice about the use of the survey dashboard was included in the NCAA Weekly to all athletics directors and conference commissioners prior to the survey launch. Of the 5,189 possible participants, there were 961 completed surveys (19 percent response rate).

6. Allowing the defensive team to huddle during a video review and/or meet with coaches along the foul line where their dugout is located. Offensive coaches may talk with the batter or on-deck batter. Neither team will be charged with a conference in these situations. Teams must be ready to resume play when the umpires return from the review. If the defensive team is not ready to resume play, a ball will be awarded to the batter. If the batter delays taking their position in the batter's box, a strike will be assessed to the batter.
