JULY 30, 2025, VIDEOCONFERENCE

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

1. **Swimming and Diving Oversight Committee update.** NCAA staff provided a brief update on the proposed new Division I governance structure.
2. **Modification to the CSCAA proposal.** The committee reviewed a requested modification to the CSCAA's recent proposal to change the individual event selection process and qualifying standards to increase institutional and conference representation at the championships. The CSCAA's original proposal set the qualifying standard for individual swimming events as the three-year average of the 80th best time on the performance list. After receiving more feedback from coaches and testing some different models with a three-year average, the CSCAA recommends revising the standard to the three-year average of the 72nd best time on the performance list for individual swimming events. The revision achieves the intended outcome to expand access without compromising the integrity of the meet. The committee voted to support the revision of the proposal. Staff edited the original annual meeting report since it had yet to be submitted to the Division I Sports Oversight Committee.
3. **Championships bid specifications.** NCAA staff reviewed the tentative timeline for the next championships site selection process. The committee reviewed and revised the bid specifications for the 2029, 2030 and 2031 NCAA Division I Men's and Women's Swimming and Diving Championships.
4. **Other business.** The 2026 championships qualifying standards will be released following the Aug. 20 Sports Oversight Committee meeting pending a decision on the committee's proposed changes to championship qualifying. NCAA staff will send out zone diving host confirmations to 2026 hosts this summer. NCAA staff provided an update that the new playing rules book and rules test should be available by mid-August. The committee chair thanked the outgoing committee members for their committee service.
5. **Future calls.** The committee will meet next on Aug. 28.
