INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

1. **Officials' application review.** The committee reviewed and approved the slate of key officials as presented from the men's and women's head swimming referees and men's and women's head diving referees. Next, the head swimming officials and designated officials coordinator will identify the 18 volunteer swimming officials for the men's and women's championships for committee approval before the end of November.
2. **Championships updates.**
 - a. **Manuals.** Staff updated the committee on the progress of the various manuals for the 2024-25 season.
 - b. **Institutional ticket offerings.** Staff updated the committee on the recent host call with Washington State University regarding the institutional ticket sales process for the 2025 championships. The host is finalizing the communications plan and process with NCAA staff. The women's championships institutional ticket email will be sent to all head coaches on Nov. 4 with submission beginning at Noon Eastern time, Nov. 11. The men's championships institutional ticket email will be sent to all head coaches on Nov. 11 with submission beginning at Noon Eastern time, Nov. 18.
3. **Diving updates.**
 - a. **Diving subcommittee meeting.** The diving subcommittee will meet at 11 a.m. Eastern time, Oct. 29.
 - b. **Zone host call.** The five zone hosts will meet with NCAA staff and committee members at 1 p.m. Eastern time, Dec. 3.
4. **Other business.** The committee reviewed results from a recent membership survey. The committee voted to move the 100-yard butterfly before the 400-yard individual medley on Friday's schedule of events at the championships. This change, effective for the 2025 championships, provides more rest time for an individual attempting to participate in both the 100-yard butterfly and 100-yard backstroke events on the same day. Ninety-three percent of swimming coaches surveyed supported the schedule change. Based on survey feedback, the committee also voted to discontinue providing full breakfast, lunch and dinner to the staffs of

the participating teams starting with the 2025 championships. The committee will repurpose that funding toward additional student-athlete experience enhancements at the finals site.
