

## 2019-20 IMPORTANT UPDATES DIVISION II MEN'S AND WOMEN'S SWIMMING AND DIVING

The NCAA Division II Men's and Women's Swimming and Diving Committee is providing these important updates that will be effective for the 2019-20 season and the 2020 NCAA Division II Men's and Women's Swimming and Diving Championships. More detailed information will be included in the NCAA Division II Men's and Women's Swimming and Diving Prechampionships Manual, which will be posted on <a href="mailto:ncaa.org">ncaa.org</a> in early December.

- 1. Minimum contests and participants requirements. Effective Sept. 1, 2019, an institution must meet the current requirements for sport sponsorship, NCAA Division II Bylaw 20.10.3.3, for swimming and diving [minimum contests (8) and participants requirements (11)] for each gender to be eligible for selection to the Division II Men's and Women's Swimming and Diving Championships.
- **2. Splits reminder.** When submitting results, coaches must also request intermediate splits within the same 72-hour deadline. The committee will continue to permit the use of 50-yard splits for relay entries.
- **3. Diving finalist introductions.** For the championships schedule of events, the committee moved the introduction of the diving finalists before the previous swim event's awards presentation.
- **4. Student-athlete introductions.** For the championships, the committee agreed to introduce student-athletes and relay teams before taking the start for the consolation finals.

## 2019-20 Important Dates

- Sunday, Sept. 1, 2019 Team roster maintenance tool is available on <a href="https://www.usaswimming.org/ncaa">www.usaswimming.org/ncaa</a>.
- Saturday, Sept. 7, 2019 Qualifying period begins Sept. 7, or on institution's fourth day of classes for the fall term as set forth in its catalog; counting Monday through Friday only, whichever is earlier.
- Ongoing Submission of meet results and requests for intermediate split times due within 72-hours of competition. See NCAA Results Reporting. www.usaswimming.org/ncaa.
- Wednesday, Sept. 11, 2019 Updates to Team Information must be submitted. www.usaswimming.org/ncaa.
- Friday, Sept. 13, 2019 All initial team rosters must be submitted. www.usaswimming.org/ncaa.
- Friday, Jan. 17, 2020 Final roster updates must be submitted. www.usaswimming.org/ncaa.
- Sunday, Feb. 23, 2020 Last day of qualification for men's and women's championships (11:59 p.m. local time).
- Monday, Feb. 24, 2020 All results must be submitted for swimming and diving by 5 p.m. Eastern time.
- Monday, Feb. 24, 2020 Online entries for swimming (USA Swimming) and diving (DiveMeets) due by 11:59 p.m. Eastern time. The swimming entry list will be posted for review at <a href="www.usaswimming.org/ncaa">www.usaswimming.org/ncaa</a>. The entry review and challenge period begins as soon as the entry list is posted.
- Tuesday, Feb. 25, 2020 Coaches who entered more than 18 swimmers must be available to receive a call from the NCAA championships manager between 8 a.m. and noon Eastern time.
- Tuesday, Feb. 25, 2020 Noon Eastern time, deadline for coaches to inform Macie McNichols (<a href="mmcnichols@usaswimming.org">mmcnichols@usaswimming.org</a>), in writing, of any swimmers who became unavailable for championships competition after entries were submitted.
- Tuesday, Feb. 25, 2020 Entry challenges are due by 3 p.m. Eastern time.

- Wednesday, Feb. 26, 2020 Official qualification lists, including alternates, will be posted on ncaa.com by 5 p.m. Eastern time.
- Friday, Feb. 28, 2020 Relay confirmations and designation of relay-only swimmers (up to four) must be submitted in writing to Marie Scovron (<a href="masked-mscovron@ncaa.org">mscovron@ncaa.org</a>) by 5 p.m. Eastern time.
- Tuesday, March 10, 2020 Diving qualification meet at the SPIRE Institute Aquatics Center, Geneva, Ohio.
- Wednesday-Saturday, March 11-14, 2020 Men's and Women's Championships at the SPIRE Institute Aquatics Center, Geneva, Ohio.
