INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

- 1. The USOPC/NCAA Para-College Inclusion Project. Representatives from the USOPC joined the committee to present several concepts for engagement at this year's championships. The committee expressed strong support for incorporating initiatives that highlight and promote the inclusion of para swimming and diving at the event. Staff will begin initial operational planning and coordination with the host to implement these initiatives effectively.
- **2. USA Swimming reporting compliance review**. The committee reviewed reports for adherence to three key policies and procedures: roster uploads, meet schedules and meet results. Institutions that failed to meet expectations in these areas will be subject to fines. The committee will continue to monitor meet result reports throughout the season leading up to the championships.
- **3. Approval of swimming key officials.** The committee reviewed and approved the swimming and volunteer officials submitted by the head referee. They also discussed options for the swim announcer. Diving officials will be approved once received from the diving referee.
