## **INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.**

• **Sport sponsorship required for championship.** The committee discussed whether an institution should be required to meet the legislated sport sponsorship minimums to qualify student-athletes for championship selection. The committee reviewed sport sponsorship data for the past five years. Correlating the data to the championships results, the members determined that only one institution, in one gender's championship, did not meet the sponsorship minimums.

The committee believes it best for Division II swimming and diving to provide an opportunity for an institution to add or grow the sport on their campus. The committee acknowledges that one of the best ways to accomplish that goal is to have a student-athlete selected to the NCAA championship. Unlike a team sport, an individual-team sport such as swimming and diving does not need to roster a specific number of student-athletes each year for an individual student-athlete to excel. Providing institutions with the option to start small, and potentially with limited scholarships, and giving them time to develop their programs is for the overall betterment of the sport.

In addition, the committee believes it is in the best interests of swimming and diving studentathletes to provide a championship opportunity based on the individual student-athlete's performance, not tied to their teammates' performances. Also, because the swimming and diving season is so long, spanning almost two semesters, few student-athletes participate in more than one sport in an academic year. Swimming and diving does not have the crossover issue that track and field would have without a sponsorship requirement for championship selection.
