

# **Roster Download Instructions For NCAA Coaches**

The online roster download tool will be used by the host teams to download Hy- Tek rosters for all teams competing in a meet. The following step- by- step instructions will help guide you through downloading the rosters from the USA Swimming website and importing into Meet Manager 2.0 or higher for use during competition.

**Step 1:** Navigate to the NCAA page on the USA Swimming website (*you might have issues if using Chrome or Firefox*): www.usaswimming.org/ncaa

Step 2: Click on your division's main menu

#### NCAA INFORMATION

USA Swimming and the NCAA have partnered to keep track of all Division I, II, & III performance times. By utilizing USA Swimming's SWIMS database, which records times for USAS members, college coaches and swimmers are now able to search for their best times, event rank within the NCAA and even look up team rosters. 

#### **NCAA Roster Download Instructions**

<u>Step 3:</u> You will be prompted for a USA Swimming username & Password at an Account Login page. If you do not already have a USA Swimming username & password, please create one. If you have one from past affiliations, you are free to use it for these purposes. Enter your username & password, then click login.




Step 4: Once you are signed in click on Roster Download

<u>Step 5:</u> At this time, it may ask you to verify your coaching contact information. Once verified, it should not ask you do this again under that username and password. After you bypass this step, you will be taken to the Roster Download page shown below.


## NCAA DIVISION I ROSTER DOWNLOAD




The system defaults to the current season. Select the division & conference of the team you wish to find in the drop-down menu and click search.

#### **NCAA Roster Download Instructions**

<u>Step 6:</u> The system then populates the teams within the division & conference you chose as seen below. You have the option to quickly view a roster by clicking on either Men or Women. Download a team's roster by clicking on Download.




<u>Step 7:</u> Save the file to either your desktop or a folder you can find easily. Notice that the file is saving in Hy3 format. Do not alter the extension at end, file name, or file type.



#### **NCAA Roster Download Instructions**

<u>Step 8:</u> The file should now be saved on your desktop, in your downloads folder or in a folder where you can find it. In MM, make sure you have created a meet that this specific roster is to be used in. Once you have opened that meet, click **File>Import>Swims Roster or NCAA Roster.** 



**Step 9:** The next prompt will look similar to the first screenshot. Click Ok. A summary should then appear stating the number of teams and athletes from the imported roster as seen below. Your import is now complete, click Ok!
