2025 NCAA Division III Men's and Women's Swimming and Diving Championships GENERAL INFORMATION

FACILITIES

The Greensboro Coliseum Complex is proud to host the 2025 NCAA Division III Men's and Women's Swimming and Diving Championships at the Greensboro Aquatic Center (GAC) in Greensboro, North Carolina. The facility address is 1921 W. Gate City Blvd., Greensboro, North Carolina 27403. Additional information about the aquatic center can be located at https://greensboroaquaticcenter.com.

Located on the campus of the Greensboro Coliseum Complex, the GAC has evolved into the largest indoor aquatic center in the country (105,323-sq. feet). The competition pool is an eight lane, 50—meter Olympic pool with two moveable bulkheads. The dive-well has two, 1-meter and two, 3-meter springboards as well as a 5-meter, 7.5-meter and 10-meter platform. The GAC has an Omega timing system with Omega starting blocks. The facility has two Daktronics scoreboards with audio and visual capabilities. The GAC has multiple locker rooms throughout the facility. The GAC has extensive permanent seating for just over 2,000 spectators. Since its opening in 2011, the state-of-the-art, multi-purpose, four-pool facility has compiled an impressive national event hosting resume including numerous USA Swimming, U.S. Masters, USA Diving, USA Synchro, NCAA, ACC and YMCA National Championships.

PARTICIPANT ENTRANCE

All credentialed participants should enter the GAC through the Training Pool doors. Credentials must be visible to gain entry to the GAC.

ATHLETIC TRAINING ROOM

Certified athletic trainers will be available for the entire meet. Murphy Wainer Orthopedics will provide a physician that will be on call for all scheduled practices and competitions. Guilford College will provide athletic training coverage for this event.

The athletic training room will be open during and after practice and competition. An athletic training area will be available to all student-athletes including heat, ice bags and electric modalities. Those student-athletes requiring the use of modalities must provide written documentation from their team athletic trainer and/or team physician. Student-athletes who require special needs should contact Ethan Michael ahead of time to help arrange such services. If your team is not traveling with a certified athletic trainer and/or team physician, prior notification is appreciated to communicate any care. Additionally, an area located off deck outside of the locker rooms and athletic training area is designated for teams to use as a student-athlete rub-down area (see facility map). Tables and/or massage therapists will not be provided by the hosts.

Water, POWERADE and cups will be available for all student-athletes on the pool deck as well as in the athletic training area. The athletic training area hours of operation are:

The meet physician will be on call throughout the meet through communication with the athletic trainers. Student-athletes with specific questions or preexisting conditions should contact the athletic trainer on site.

LOCKER ROOMS

Locker rooms are located on the East side of the GAC under the spectator stands as well as off the training pool deck. There are four locker rooms – two for men and two for women. There are also three gender neutral changing rooms, located near the training pool. Only participants are permitted in the locker rooms. Restrooms are available in the ondeck classrooms and concourse area of the GAC. No towels and/or locker combinations will be provided.

STUDENT-ATHLETE HOSPITALITY

POWERADE product as well as snacks will be provided throughout the championships beginning Monday night through Saturday evening.

The GAC and the NCAA swimming and diving committee assume no responsibility for loss of personal articles. Each competitor and coach are responsible for their own property.

MASSAGE AREA

Massage tables can be set up on the shallow end of the training pool deck in the designated spots. Space is first-come, first-served. Massage therapists must have a deck pass as part of the team travel party.

TEAM BANNERS POLICY

Teams are permitted to bring a single institutional banner or sign to display at the GAC. No sheet banners are permitted. Please attempt to limit the size of the banner to no bigger than 5' X 8' if possible. Spectators are **not permitted** to hang any banners or signs around the pool or in the stands. Team banners should be turned into the host staff at registration. The host staff will be responsible for hanging each team's banner above or near the designated team seating area on deck. Teams that would like to retrieve their banners before the end of the championships should arrange to do so at the administration table (located on deck next to the head table) at least one hour prior to departure. Near the conclusion of the championships on Saturday evening, the host staff will take down all remaining banners for teams to pick up as they exit the pool deck.

VIDEORECORDING

Institutions are permitted to videotape championships competition by their teams or their individual student-athletes for archival, coaching, or instructional purposes. Each institution is permitted to use one camera and may videotape only that portion of the competition in which it participates. The videotapes may not be used for any commercial purposes. Limited space will be available in a marked area at the top of the grandstands with those area(s) being designated by the Division III Men's and Women's Swimming and Diving Committee. Coaches wishing to videotape performances should do so using only battery power. Coaches will not be allowed to plug in any cameras or battery chargers in the GAC.

WARM-UP/WARM-DOWN

Both the warm-up and competition pools will be open at the scheduled times on practice days and during the meet. The competition pool will close after the last race. The training pool will be available for cool down for one hour after the last race.

RESULTS

Final results of each session's competition will be posted in the mailboxes located directly behind the administration table. Results will be available on the main concourse for spectators. An NCAA championship webpage on NCAA.com will also post live results, team scores, and a recap after each session.

CHAMPIONSHIPS MATERIALS

The NCAA developed a website to retain key information from every member institution which may participate in an NCAA championship. The NCAA and its partners (i.e. Turner/CBS, ESPN, IMG College, Van Wagner Sports & Entertainment, etc.) are required to use the site to access all logos, fight songs, rosters, photos of student-athletes, teams, coaches, administrators and campus for use on selection shows, game programs, banquet videos and video boards at NCAA championships. For this site to be completely effective, it requires full cooperation from participating institutions. Please log on to www.ncaachampionship.info (username: ncaaschools; password: ncaaftp) to upload logo and photos of participating student-athletes for your institution.

NCAA ACADEMIC RECOGNITION PROGRAM

The Elite 90 award is presented to the student-athlete with the highest cumulative grade-point average competing at the finals site for each of the NCAA's 90 championships. Each institution that has at least one student-athlete qualify for the finals round/site is eligible to nominate a student-athlete to win the award for that championship. The submission deadline for nomination for NCAA Division III Men's and Women's Swimming and Diving is **5 p.m.** (Eastern) on Friday, March 14.

MEDICAL SERVICES

Student-athletes requiring physician evaluation, medications, etc., should make requests through one of the on-site athletic trainers if assistance is needed. Student-athletes must complete the medical information sheets and have them available in the event treatment is needed during the championships. An EMT will be on site throughout the championships.

PARKING

Coaches, officials, and committee members will receive parking passes. All other parking will be sold by the parking attendants stationed in the parking lot. All-session parking passes will be sold on Tuesday, March 18 and Wednesday, March 19 for \$30. A daily pass is available at the rate of \$10. There will be no parking charges for the practice day on Monday, March 17.

WEB CAST

These championships can be viewed via a live web cast at NCAA.com.

CONFIRMATION OF ENTRIES

Registration and packet pick-up will be in Meeting Room 2 located in the adjacent Special Event Center. Upon arrival, the coach or an official representative of the institution must register and pick up an entry list and other pertinent championships materials. The coach or representative must sign an official receipt form indicating a correct entry of the individual(s)/team as listed on the entry list.

DECK PASSES/CREDENTIALS

Admittance to the Venue. (For championship ticket information, see page 5 of this manual.) All institutional personnel not included in the official travel party must purchase a ticket for admittance to the venue. Only members of an institution's official travel party will be issued deck passes. The official travel party is determined by the following formula:

Access to the Deck. All individuals must have a deck pass to gain admittance to the deck. One deck pass per team (one per men's and/or one per women's teams) are available for purchase at a fee of \$55 each (cash or credit card accepted). Institutional personnel must provide photo identification and sign the deck pass at the time of pick-up. The cost to replace a lost deck pass will be \$75. Student-athletes, coaches and institutional personnel must visibly wear deck passes on deck at all times. Deck passes are non-transferable. Institutions that provide deck passes to unauthorized personnel during the championships will be fined \$100 and may be subject to additional sanctions by the NCAA Division III Swimming and Diving Committee. Athletic trainers not included in the official travel party are subject to the same restrictions.

No one is allowed to enter the facility without proper identification.

NCAA SENIOR RECOGNITION PRESENTATION

Coaches and/or university sports information staff are encouraged to submit high resolution head shots of qualified senior student-athletes to J.J. Nekoloff at jnekoloff@odaconline.com. The photos will be used in the senior recognition presentation at the competition venue on Friday evening. Photos will be accepted from now until March 14. Any photos sent after this deadline are subject to exclusion from the recognition.

TEAM SEATING SELECTION PROCESS

- Institutions qualifying 10 or more student-athletes will be given the opportunity to select seating prior to the coaches meeting. Corey Bray will contact each coach to select their seating locations.
- The institution qualifying the greatest number of student-athletes will select first, and selections will continue from

highest down, in order, until all teams qualifying 10 or more student-athletes have selected. Ties will be broken based on the previous year's combined institutional points scored.

SCRATCH DEADLINES

Scratches are to be made by the coach or official representative by depositing scratch slips in the scratch box by the designated deadlines. A receipt form will be used for scratch verification. All entries not scratched will become official entries. Each coach or official representative must also submit a list of dives by the scratch deadline.

The scratch box will be located at the meet administration table on deck next to the meet operations room on the pool deck. Scratch deadlines are as follows:




