



**REPORT OF THE
NCAA DIVISION III MEN'S AND WOMEN'S SWIMMING AND DIVING COMMITTEE
NOV. 13, 2025, VIDEOCONFERENCE**

ACTION ITEMS.

1. Legislative items.

2. Nonlegislative items.

- **Site selections for 2026 diving regionals.**

(1) Recommendation. That the following sites serve as the regional diving hosts for the 2026 Division III men's and women's diving regionals:

Region	Host	Location
Central	Kalamazoo College	Kalamazoo College Natatorium
Midwest/South/West	Emory University	Woodruff Physical Education Center
Northeast-North	Connecticut College	Lott Natatorium
Northeast-South	Rochester Institute of Technology	Judson Pool

(2) Effective date. Immediate.

(3) Rationale. These sites were reviewed and approved by the men's and women's swimming and diving committee to ensure they meet bid specifications. Each site provided a thorough description of their facility and how they would successfully run the competition. This list strikes a balance between previous hosts and new hosts. The committee feels confident the proposed hosts will meet the regional meet requirements.

(4) Estimated budget impact. Diving regional hosts are given a \$2,400 stipend.

(5) Student-athlete impact. Each site will provide a positive experience for the participants.

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

1. Approval of Oct.13 report. The committee reviewed and approved the report of its Oct. 13 videoconference.

2. Diving regional site representatives. The chair requested each committee member to check their availability to serve as a diving regional site representative and communicate that availability to the championship manager. Each committee member was also asked to provide

the championship manager with the names and contact information for potential site representatives.

3. **Diving judge qualifications.** The committee received a brief update on the process to create a document outlining diving judge qualifications.
4. **2026 championships officials.** The committee received an update on the process to secure the swimming officials (both paid and volunteer). The committee approved the diving judges recommended by the diving coordinator and instructed the championship manager to communicate that approval to the diving coordinator.
5. **Championship format survey results.** The committee reviewed and discussed the championship format survey results. The committee will consider making minor changes to the competition schedule and format to reduce the length of each session of the 2026 championships (e.g., eliminating the student-athlete interviews). After experiencing the results of those changes, the committee will further discuss the relay format and session start times during its annual meeting for possible changes starting with the 2027 championships.
6. **Head diving coach contact information.** The committee received an update on the process for the national office to begin collecting head diving coach contact information.
7. **2025-26 manuals.** The committee received an update on the process to update and publish the 2025-26 manuals.
8. **Future meetings.** The committee reviewed the future meeting schedule and requested staff to collect committee member availability information to possibly change the December meeting date and time.
