



**REPORT OF THE
NCAA DIVISION II MEN'S AND WOMEN'S TENNIS COMMITTEE
SEPT. 9, 2026, VIDEOCONFERENCE**

ACTION ITEMS.

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

- 1. New committee member welcome.** The committee welcomed its new representative from the East Region, Greg Coache, head men's and women's tennis coach at Southern New Hampshire University. The committee is still awaiting recommendations from the Division II Nominating Committee for new representatives from the Central and South Central Regions.
- 2. 2026-27 access ratios and regional bid allocations.** The committee reviewed the 2026-27 access ratios and regional bid allocations for both men's and women's tennis. The committee noted that the men's regional bid allocations will remain unchanged for the upcoming championship year. On the women's side, the Atlantic Region's allocation will increase from seven to eight bids, while the East Region's allocation will decrease from five to four bids.

The committee also noted a continued decline in sponsorship numbers, with five fewer institutions sponsoring men's tennis and 11 fewer institutions sponsoring women's tennis compared to the previous year. Additionally, the committee discussed that this marks the second consecutive year that women's tennis has not met the Division II Championships Committee access ratio policy.

- 3. Tennis landing page.** The committee reviewed the updated tennis landing page resources, including links to the June annual report, the NPI report, and the NPI webinar. The committee emphasized the importance of promoting the NPI report and NPI webinar to coaches to help them better understand the new ranking and selection system that will be used during the 2026-27 championship year.
- 4. 2026-27 committee timeline.** The committee reviewed its timeline for the 2026-27 championship season, including monthly committee meetings, key championship deadlines, the preliminary-round hosting bid timeline, and important dates leading up to the championship. The committee also reviewed the schedule for committee members who will be on site during the championship.
