



VOLLEYMETRICS VIDEO EXCHNAGE GUIDELINES

Volleymetrics is the video exchange provider for the NCAA Division II Women's Volleyball Championship. Hudl will provide access to its Volleymetrics online portal for each selected team.

All teams participating in the NCAA Division II Women's Volleyball Championship are required to upload video and the official scoresheet from their last match (e.g., conference tournament match or final regular season match for teams not participating in a conference tournament) and upload video to the Volleymetrics platform throughout the NCAA tournament. All uploads require a <u>full match scoresheet</u>. Upload of video and full match scoresheet must be completed by 8 p.m. Eastern, the Tuesday after selections are announced on Monday.

Video Requirements

- 1. When recording, cameras should be:
 - Centered behind one of the end lines (rather than in a corner or on the side of the court), a minimum of 15 feet from the end line and at least 10 feet above court level;
 - Away from high traffic areas where people will be sitting, standing or walking; and
 - On a tripod or mounted to a wall or railing.
- 2. The *best* view will include the far end line through the net, with one to two feet of extra space between the bottom of the court and the camera frame. It is important that jersey numbers and the full court are visible so that Volleymetrics can tag with accuracy.



3. Each video upload should be a single file, 3GB or less. Files may need to be merged or compressed before uploading. Click here for those instructions. Record each match at 720p resolution to maintain manageable file sizes.
