The following information is provided to assist during the water polo season and in preparing for the 2019 National Collegiate Men's Water Polo Championship:

1. Results Reporting. Beginning this year, water polo sports information directors (SID) will be required to enter scores following each contest using the statistics database. Michelle Watsky ([mwatsky@ncaa.org](mailto:mwatsky@ncaa.org)) at the NCAA national office has provided more information to your SID.
2. Complimentary Coaches Membership to ArbiterSports. Head coaches will receive complimentary access to the Advantage website. Please click [here](#) to begin registration. Registrations must be under the head coach's name and email address. This information will be verified by NCAA staff.
3. Pre-Championship Manual. Coaches are reminded to review the 2019 National Collegiate Men's Water Polo Pre-Championship Manual. The pre-championship manual is a resource for institutions to prepare for the championships. The 2019 National Collegiate Men's Water Polo Pre-Championship Manual will be posted [here](#) in October.
4. Opening Round Hosting. The preliminary round information and bid checklist may be found [here](#). Any institution interested in hosting an opening round game should submit a bid to host. Teams that are competing for their respective conference championship are encouraged to submit a bid to host an opening round game. All materials are due by 5 p.m. Eastern time, Friday, November 1.
