INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

- **Rules Interpreter.** A selection committee (see below) was established to review applications and conduct interviews for the position to be the first Rules Interpreter for the newly established championship of Women's Wrestling. The applicant group, consisting of 26 candidates, was narrowed to four finalist and video interviews were conducted for each one. The selection committee recommends to the Women's Wrestling Committee, Jackie Paquette, for the position.

Jackie Paquette, current a National Wrestling Coaches Association (NWCA) employee has been involved with the prior women's championship for multiple years and has played a key part in their rule book. The rulebook used by that group will also be used for NCAA National Collegiate Women's Wrestling. Jackie has been a part of assisting division II men's wrestling for multiple years as well (even prior to her current role with the NWCA). Prior to working at the NWCA, Jackie worked at the University of Indianapolis as the Senior Woman Administrator. Jackie has extensive experience in the sport along and has tremendous relationships with the collegiate wrestling space. With Jackie Paquette's considerable collegiate wrestling and professional experiences, she is the ideal candidate for this position.
