The following footnotes refer to the Penalty Table on page 55:

<sup>1</sup>Point assessments are added to opponent's score.

<sup>2</sup>Disqualify, deduction of one team point, ejection for the remainder of the event, loss of all previously earned team points and suspension from the subsequent event. (See Rule 5.5.9.)

<sup>3</sup>Offender (other than medical personnel) is suspended from the team's next regularly scheduled competition.

<sup>4</sup>Cumulative for each institution throughout a dual meet, single and multi-day tournaments, and both dual individual and team-advancement events.

<sup>5</sup>Medical personnel is suspended from the team's next regularly scheduled home competition.
