NCAA Division I Academic Performance Program Data Review Process – Frequently Asked Questions

Question No. 1: How long will the data review take?

Answer: The NCAA Division I Academic Performance Program (APP) Data

Review process typically takes three-four months from the date of the

initial teleconference to the final report arriving on campus.

Question No. 2: How should the information be organized?

Answer: It is easiest for the NCAA staff/representative reviewer if the information

is organized by the request items outlined in Attachment A of the initial

request for documentation, by team, by cohort year.

Question No. 3: Do I need to provide a transcript for each year the student-athlete is

included in the cohort if they are included in more than one cohort year

under review?

Answer: No. You can provide one transcript and note on the transcript the cohort

years the student-athlete is included in.

Question No. 4: Are we required to submit official transcripts?

Answer: Yes; however, the transcripts do not need to be printed on official

transcript paper. They must be printed by the registrar's office. Please keep in mind the readability of the documents being sent, if the copy

cannot be read, it cannot be used to verify data.

Question No. 5: We cannot find a transcript, what should we do?

Answer: If a transcript from a previous institution cannot be provided, please note

that with the submission of documents.

Question No. 6: What sort of financial aid records should be provided?

Answer: The financial aid documentation provided must show disbursement of aid

by term. This could be print screens from your student information

system.

Question No. 7: As we gather information, we have identified some data errors, what

should we do?

Answer: If you identify issues, summarize the issues identified and include them

with the submission of documentation. The issues will be reviewed by the

- -----

staff/representative assigned to your institution. Further, it will be noted in the preliminary report that the institution identified the issue with the submission of documentation.

Question No. 8: Through the data review process, we identified some areas for

improvement in our certification process, are there examples of the

certification forms other institutions use to certify eligibility?

Answer: Yes, there are examples from other institutions. Contact your contact

staff/representative to discuss your process and potential examples from

like institutions.

Question No. 9: We have experienced significant staff turnover and have a hiring freeze on

campus, is there any flexibility in the timeline for the review?

Answer: Yes, there can be flexibility in the timeline. Contact your contact staff/

representative to discuss a reasonable timeline.

Question No. 10: Through the data review process, we identified some cases where student-

athletes competed while ineligible, how should we handle?

Answer: If violations are identified through the data review process, your

institution should self-report those issues to the NCAA enforcement team.
