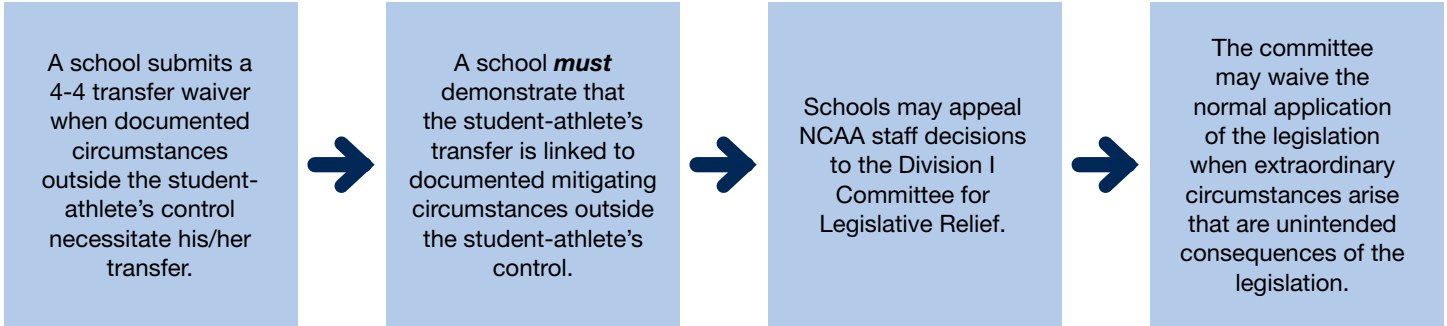




Transfer Waiver Process

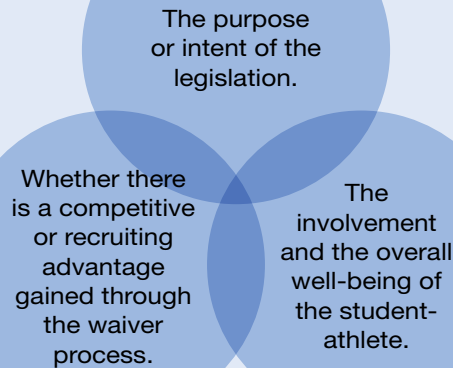
A waiver is needed when a student-athlete wants to transfer from one four-year school to another and does not satisfy a transfer exception. Here is a look at how the process works and the options available at each step.

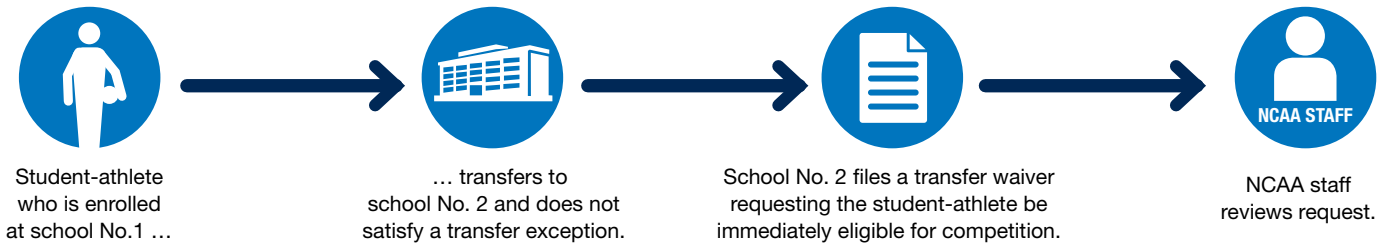
The Division I Committee for Legislative Relief is made up of seven members from Division I schools or conferences.

Decisions made by the committee are final, binding and not subject to any further review.

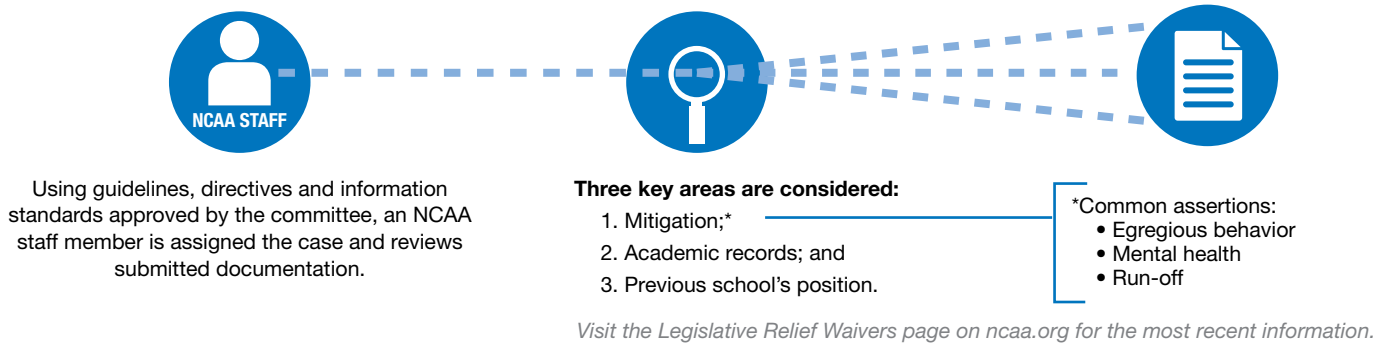
Transfer Waiver Process continued

WAIVER PROCESS BREAKDOWN

The typical decision turnaround time for waivers is 21 days. Transfer waiver requests are *never* considered urgent.
