1. **Review information related to notification of transfer windows.** The committees reviewed and discussed the 2024 fall football student-athlete transfer data and year-over-year transfer trends. The committee requested information on the impact of increased transfer rates on NCAA graduation rates and graduation success rate data. Additionally, the committee received an overview of a notification of transfer window model developed at the FBS head coaches meeting during the 2025 American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) Convention.
