1. **Key issues update.** The FBSOC and FCSOC chairs provided updates on items their respective committees discussed during their October 7 meetings.
2. **NCAA Sports Science Institute update.** Dr. Deena Casiero, NCAA chief medical officer and senior vice president of the NCAA Sports Science Institute was introduced to the committees and noted participation in future NCAA Division I Football Playing and Practice Season Subgroup videoconferences.
3. **Review recommendation to transition National Letter of Intent program to NCAA legislation.** The committees received an update on the recommendation from the NCAA Division I Legislative Committee to transition the National Letter of Intent program to NCAA legislation. The committee provided feedback on the impact the proposed changes may have on football prospective student-athletes who participate in multiple sports.
