

REPORT OF THE NCAA DIVISION I FOOTBALL BOWL SUBDIVISION OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE DECEMBER 5, 2024, VIDEOCONFERENCE

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

- 1. Football Playing Rules update. The committee received an update from Steve Shaw, secretary-rules editor of the NCAA Football Rules Committee. The update included the implementation of several technology items, including the use of coach-to-player communication and the use of tablets for coaching purposes. Updated game data was shared with the committee, noting a slight decrease in the overall number of plays and scoring in the game. The FBSOC also discussed investigating potential solutions for feigning injuries and focusing attention on sportsmanship concerns. The Football Rules Committee meets February 25-27, 2025.
- 2. FCS to FBS reclassification update. The committee received an update on institutions in the Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) to FBS reclassification process. The committee will review reports from the institutions involved in the FCS to FBS reclassification process during the summer of 2025.
- 3. College Football Playoff update. The FBSOC received an update from the executive director of the College Football Playoff (CFP) regarding the work of the CFP selection committee leading up to the announcement of the official CFP field on Sunday December 8, 2024.
- 4. Update on 2024-25 FBS postseason deserving teams. The committee received an update on postseason bowl games, noting there are 82 FBS teams eligible for the 41 certified postseason bowls.
- 5. Playing and Practice Season Subgroup update. The committee received an update from the subgroup's November videoconference and the revised timeline for the subgroup's review of playing and practice season legislative concepts following the Board of Directors November 11, 2024, action to adopt the interim policy and legislative priorities for Division I to focus the work of committees in the Division I governance structure.
