JUNE 5, 2025, VIDEOCONFERENCE

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

1. **NCAA Division I Decision-Making Working Group update.** The committee received an update about the NCAA Division I Decision-Making Working Group and provided feedback on FBSOC's oversight of football rules with the Football Championship Subdivision Oversight Committee and the potential for weighted voting for autonomy conferences on the Football Bowl Subdivision Oversight Committee in a new Division I governance structure.
2. **Transfer Windows and Related Topics Subgroup.** The committee received an update regarding the subgroup's work. Additionally, the committee provided initial feedback supporting the spring and summer football activities concept that permits two practice periods and does not require enrollment in summer school. The committee did not take a position on the concept of joint practices or scrimmages, noting that additional discussion is needed. The committee discussed its preference for a single notification of transfer window model and noted that while the NCAA Division I Football Student-Athlete Connection Group has maintained their support of a two-transfer portal window model, the FSACG indicated a willingness to have additional conversation about the timing and duration of a single portal window as the subgroup continues to develop a new spring and summer football playing and practice model.
3. **Update on the football bowl certification framework for the upcoming postseason bowl bid cycle.** The committee received an update about ongoing discussions with the FBS conferences regarding the future bowl certification framework and the role of the NCAA in certifying postseason bowl contests moving forward. The 2025-26 academic year is the final year of the current bowl certification framework.
4. **NCAA Division I Football Student-Athlete Connection Group update.** The committee received an update from the May 18 FSACG videoconference. The FSACG's next videoconference is Sunday, July 13.
5. **NCAA legal issues update.** The committee received an update from the NCAA Office of Legal Affairs.
6. **NCAA Division I governance update.** The committee received an update on recent and upcoming Division I governance meetings.
7. **College Football Playoff update.** The committee deferred this item to a future meeting.
