INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

- 1. Review of NCAA Division I Cabinet referral. The Football Bowl Subdivision Oversight Committee discussed the NCAA Division I Cabinet referral to review the impact of the adoption of Proposal No. 2025-28 (recruiting -- football -- notification of transfer window and FBS recruiting calendar) on midyear transfers to quarter institutions and postgraduate student-athletes. The committee discussed the variances among academic calendars and potential relief for institutions who may be unable to enroll midyear transfer student-athletes due to the timing of the new notification of transfer window. The committee did not support a waiver of the full-time enrollment requirement with broad application and intends to discuss guidelines for NCAA staff to consider when processing individual waivers of the full-time enrollment requirement during its December 4 videoconference. The committee also requested NCAA staff collect data to understand the impact of NCAA Division I Proposal No. 2025-28 on midyear transfers to quarter institutions and postgraduate student-athletes.
- 2. Review of NCAA Division I Football Bowl Subdivision recruiting calendar. The committee reviewed the recently adopted NCAA Division I Proposal No. 2025-28 and its impact on the FBS recruiting calendar. The committee agreed to maintain the two- and four-year college midyear transfer quiet period from January 1 through 4, 2026, for the 2025-2026 academic year. The committee indicated a preference to proceed with the 2025-26 recruiting calendar as planned to better understand the impact of Proposal No. 2025-28 on the midyear transfer quiet period and referred the quiet period to the football calendar subgroup to review for the 2026-27 academic year and beyond.
- 3. Request to waive first contest legislation in 2026-27. The committee discussed a legislative relief waiver request to allow an institution to conduct its first contest prior to the legislated first contest date. The committee will continue its discussion of the legislative relief waiver during its December 4 videoconference.
- **4. Update on the NCAA Division I Football Rules Subcommittee.** The committee will receive an update from the NCAA Division I Football Rules Subcommittee at a future videoconference.
- 5. Approval of the NCAA Division I Football Bowl Subdivision Oversight Committee reports. The committee approved the September 29 and October 6-7 FBSOC reports.
