**INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.**

1. **NCAA Division I Football Championship Committee update.** The FCSOC received an update on the NCAA Division I Football Championship.
2. **Four-year college undergraduate transfer update.** The FCSOC received an update on the current transfer landscape, including the four-year college National Letter of Intent and the work of the Transfer Waiver Advisory Panel to discuss legislative alternatives to replace the general rule of an academic year of residency, rather than continuing to rely upon a waiver process to determine eligibility outcomes student-athletes who in most cases, have transferred once previously.
3. **Update on NCAA Football Rules Committee.** Ty Halpin, director of NCAA championships, provided an update on Football Rules Committee topics for discussion and upcoming Football Bowl Subdivision Conference Football Administrator meetings.
4. **NCAA Division I governance update.** The committee received an update on the recent NCAA Division I Council meeting that occurred on January 10, 2024, at the NCAA Convention.
5. **Update on the 2024 American Football Coaches Association Convention.** Todd Berry, executive director of the AFCA, provided an update on the 2024 AFCA Convention. Berry shared the AFCA's perspective on the impact of Name, Image and Likeness and the transfer portal on Division I college football, the importance of maintaining academics in college football, the current and future impact of moving the early National Letter of Intent signing date and technology within the sport. It was noted that Craig Bohl, former head coach at the University of Wyoming and North Dakota State University, was announced as the new AFCA executive director and will start in the role in February 2024.
