INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

1. **Legislative Action -- Recruiting -- Football -- Official Visits.** The NCAA Division I Football Championship Oversight Committee adopted NCAA Division I Proposal No. 2023-44, in championship subdivision football, to increase the maximum number of institutional official visits from 56 to 70 and remove two legislative exceptions that increased the maximum number of institutional official visits in specific circumstances (i.e., unused visits from the previous year and head coaching change). The adopted proposal is subject to review by the NCAA Division I Council during its January 10, 2024, meeting.
2. **NCAA Division I Football Championship Committee update.** The committee received an update on the championship committee's November 17-19 meeting and selection of the field for the NCAA Division I Football Championship.
3. **Update on the 2024 National Football League (NFL) Draft, professional tryouts and agents.** The committee received an update on educational information regarding the 2024 National Football League (NFL) Draft, tryouts and agents. The NCAA Enforcement staff recently sent an educational memo to the membership about the 2024 NFL Draft and other important information regarding professional tryouts and agents.
4. **Update on NCAA Football Rules Committee.** Ty Halpin, director of NCAA championships, provided an update on the recent meetings of the Football Rules Committee. A playing rules survey will be available January 15 through February 15, 2024.
5. **Update on the NCAA Division I Football Bowl Subdivision Oversight Committee.** The committee received an update on recent and upcoming Football Bowl Subdivision Oversight Committee meetings.
