

REPORT OF THE NCAA DIVISION I FOOTBALL CHAMPIONSHIP SUBDIVISION OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE OCTOBER 6-7, 2025, MEETING

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

- 1. NCAA Division I Football Championship Committee. The committee received an update from the Division I Football Championship Committee regarding the current landscape of the FCS Championship, including the selection process and metrics used by the championship committee to select the field. Updates were provided on programming and events that will occur in Nashville, the championship site for the next two years. The committee was also advised that the host portal is open from October 6 November 6 for institutions submitting bids to serve as a host site for the 2025-26 NCAA Division I Football Championship.
- **2. Division I Football Rules Subcommittee.** The committee received an overview of the NCAA Division I Football Rules Subcommittee, including the subcommittee's composition, charge and authority.
- 3. **Identify FCSOC Strategic Priorities.** The committee identified championship subdivision football strategic priorities for the 2025-26 academic year. Priorities identified by the committee included a review of the playing season (i.e., spring and summer calendars), the four-game participation exception, the impact of conference realignment on scheduling, and potential referrals to the football rules subcommittee.
- 4. Joint meeting with the NCAA Division I Academics and Eligibility Committee, NCAA Division I Football Bowl Subdivision Oversight Committee, NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Oversight Committee and NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Oversight Committee. The FCSOC received an update from the NCAA Office of Legal Affairs, NCAA Government Relations, and the Collegiate Sports Commission.
- **5. Appointment of new members.** The committee appointed new committee representatives for FCSOC vacancies. Notifications to the appointees will follow the established process and rosters will be updated in accordance with the start date for service.
- **6. American Football Coaches Association update.** The committee received an update from the AFCA.
- 7. **Review of draft committee policies and procedures.** The committee received an update from NCAA staff on draft committee policies and procedures, which will be reviewed in further detail and approved at a future meeting.
- **8. NCAA Division I Football Bowl Subdivision Oversight Committee update.** The committee received an update on the recent work of the FBSOC, including potential modification of the head coaching change exception to the notification-of-transfer period.
