## **INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.**

- 1. Review of the Division I Council-Governance Proposals in the June 2025 Council-Governance Legislative Cycle. The NCAA Division I Legislative Committee reviewed the legislative proposals in the June 2025 Division I Council-governance legislative cycle. The Legislative Committee supported NCAA Division I Proposal Nos. 2025-3 through 2025-6 being presented as a consent package for consideration by the council during its June meeting.
- **2. Review of Requests for Legislative Action as Expedited Legislation.** The Legislative Committee reviewed the three recommendations for the council to adopt expedited legislation at its June meeting.
- 3. Review of Division I Legislative Audit. The Legislative Committee received an overview of Division I legislation that may be appropriate for deregulation or adjustment based on the new regulatory environment following implementation of the *House* settlement. The committee supported the identified inventory and noted priority should be given to several rules applications as soon as the new governance structure and the *House* settlement implementation efforts are operational.
- **4. Update on Division I Governance Issues.** The Legislative Committee received an update on the work of the NCAA Division I Decision-Making Working Group and ongoing efforts to streamline and simplify the Division I governance process.
- 5. NCAA Division I Committee for Legislative Relief Report. The Legislative Committee received the Committee for Legislative Relief's report from its May 13, 2025, videoconference.
- **6. Approval of Legislative Committee May 12 Report.** The Legislative Committee approved the report of its May 12 meeting.
