



**REPORT OF THE NCAA
DIVISION I MEN'S BASKETBALL OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE
FEBRUARY 3, 2023, VIDEOCONFERENCE**

ACTION ITEMS.

- **Legislative items.**
 - Men's Basketball – July 2023 Recruiting Calendar.
 - (1) Recommendation. That the NCAA Division I Council Coordination Committee adopt temporary emergency legislation in men's basketball to amend the July 2023 recruiting calendar to establish an evaluation period from July 15-16, 2023.
 - (2) Effective date. Immediate. Applicable for July 2023 only.
 - (3) Rationale. With the NCAA College Basketball Academy moving from a six-day, two-session model to a four-day, single-session model, two currently legislated evaluation period days will go unused in 2023. By moving the two evaluation period days to earlier in July 2023, this model maintains the current number of July evaluation days (10) including a mix of weekday and weekend evaluation opportunities, allows for travel between multiple events over longer evaluation period during the month and maintains the opportunity for coaches to work with their teams earlier in the week prior to going on the road to recruit.
 - (4) Estimated budget impact. None.
 - (5) Student-athlete impact. Provides an additional weekend of opportunities for prospective student-athletes to be evaluated while maintaining the ability for coaches to work with their current student-athletes early in the week and evaluate prospects during the latter part of the week.

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

1. **Update and discussion on NCAA Division I legislative proposals impacting men's basketball.** The NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Oversight Committee received an update on potential modifications and the process for NCAA Division I Council to further review NCAA Division I Proposal No. 2022-32 (Campus Visits). Specifically, the proposal was not acted upon during the business session at the NCAA Convention in January 2023 but was referred back to the Division I Legislative Committee to determine how the proposal could be divided into distinct elements prior to the April Council meeting.

The oversight committee also received an update on how currently tabled NCAA Division I Proposal No. 2021-22 (Reduction from Five to Three Official Visits Per Prospect) has been impacted by Proposal No. 2022-32. Specifically, the proposal was tabled as the NCAA Division I Legislative Committee Modernization of Rules Subcommittee developed modernization concepts around campus visits. Currently, Proposal No. 2021-22 remains tabled pending potential action by the Council on Proposal No. 2022-32 in April.

2. **Discuss institutional limits on men's basketball official visits.** The oversight committee received an update on recent legislative relief waivers that have been processed by staff and current institutional official visit limitation legislation in men's basketball, which allows an institution to provide twenty-eight official visits over a two-year rolling period. The committee discussed whether a potential change to the legislation should be considered and what the appropriate model for institutional limits may be best in the future. Further, the committee discussed the potential for a blanket waiver that would increase the institutional official visit limitation in men's basketball by 25% to 35% over the two-year rolling period. The committee requested further feedback from the National Association of Basketball Coaches on the appropriate percentage increase prior to the committee formally considering a blanket waiver request. The oversight committee will continue its discussion during its March 3 videoconference.
3. **Discuss National Basketball Association pre-draft process.** The committee continued its discussion on how potential future changes to the NBA and National Basketball Players Association collective bargaining agreement may impact current NCAA legislation; specifically if the NBA draft eligibility rule or the free agency policy are changed in the new collective bargaining agreement. The committee noted that it might be beneficial to take a more wholistic review of NCAA legislation related to the "NBA pre-draft process" given the current environment (e.g., NCAA Division I Transformation Committee recommendation to review legislation related to professional team opportunities, impact of name, image and likeness policy on use of agents). The oversight committee will continue its discussion at a future meeting. The committee also received an update on the upcoming release of educational resources related to the 2023 NBA pre-draft process.
4. **Men's College Basketball Academy update and impact on July recruiting calendar.** The committee received an update on the logistics and operations for the 2023 Men's College Basketball Academy, including an update on the host city, proposed event dates, planned life skills programming and overall academy schedule. Further, the oversight committee made a recommendation to modify the July 2023 recruiting calendar to include a certified nonscholastic evaluation period July 15-16, 2023. The Council Coordination Committee will act on the recommendation during its February 8, 2023, teleconference.
5. **College basketball summer initiative update.** The committee received an update on the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Oversight Committee Men's Basketball Summer Basketball Initiative Working Group's January 23 meeting in which the working group began developing various concepts for consideration. The working group will continue to provide the committee with monthly updates.
6. **NABC update.** The committee received an update from the NABC and its current work on the association's upcoming convention in conjunction with the 2023 Men's Final Four.
7. **Identification of discussion topics for upcoming NCAA Division I Men's and Women's Basketball Oversight Committees' joint meeting.** The oversight committee reviewed topics for discussion during the upcoming joint Men's and Women's Basketball Oversight Committees meeting in April 2023.

8. **NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Oversight Committee January 10 videoconference report.** The committee reviewed and approved the committee's January 10 videoconference report.
