



**REPORT OF THE NCAA
DIVISION I MEN'S BASKETBALL OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE
FEBRUARY 26, 2026, VIDEOCONFERENCE**

ACTION ITEMS.

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

1. **Legislative actions.** The Division I Men's Basketball Oversight Committee adopted the following legislative proposals. The two adopted proposals are not final until reviewed by the NCAA Division I Cabinet during its April 2026 meeting.
 - **NCAA Division I Proposal No. 2026-3 – Recruiting – Evaluations – Men's Basketball – May and July Evaluation Periods – International Evaluations.** The oversight committee adopted Proposal No. 2026-3. The proposal, in men's basketball, permits evaluations of international prospective student-athletes participating on international scholastic or nonscholastic teams during regularly scheduled practice and competition during the May and July evaluation periods.
 - **NCAA Division I Proposal No. 2026-5 – Recruiting – Unofficial (Nonpaid) Visit – First Opportunity to Visit -- Men's Basketball – Any Time.** The oversight committee adopted Proposal No. 2026-5. The proposal, in men's basketball, permits unofficial visits at any time, subject to recruiting calendar restrictions per Division I Bylaw 13.17.2.
2. **NCAA legal update.** The oversight committee received a legal update on several items impacting Division I men's basketball.
3. **NCAA Division I legislative update.** In preparation for anticipated action during the February 27 joint Division I Men's and Women's Basketball Oversight Committees' meeting, the oversight committee reviewed Proposal Nos. 2026-2 (Athletics Personnel and Recruiting – Limitations on the Number of Coaches and Off-Campus Recruiters – Basketball), 2026-6 (Playing and Practice Seasons – Summer Athletic Activities – Skill-Related Instruction – Basketball – Eliminate Four-Hour Rule), 2026-7 (Playing and Practice Seasons – Preseason Practice Scrimmages/Exhibition Contests – Basketball – Up to Three) and 2026-8 (Playing and Practice Seasons – Foreign Tours – Time Lapse Between Tours – Basketball – Once Per Year), and the associated question-and-answer documents developed for each proposal. In its review of Proposal No. 2026-2, the oversight committee discussed the application of the individual associated with a prospective student-athlete (IAWP) legislation. The proposal's associated question and answer document will address specific IAWP scenarios. Additionally, the oversight committee will collaborate with the Women's Basketball Oversight Committee and the Division I Football Bowl Subdivision and Football Championship Subdivision Oversight Committees to review IAWP legislation and consider potential changes to the legislation during upcoming meetings.

4. **Outside competition discussion.** The oversight committee continued its discussion on outside competition rules in basketball. Specifically, the oversight committee reviewed previous recommendations made by the oversight committee's College Basketball Summer Basketball Initiative Working Group and Outside Competition Working Group. Generally, the oversight committee supported a review of the outside competition rules and indicated concepts should consider the men's basketball playing season and championship. Lastly, the oversight committee referred the outside competition concepts to the oversight committee's administrative subcommittee for development. The committee anticipates introduction of a proposal for the October legislative cycle, following discussion with the Women's Basketball Oversight Committee.
5. **2026 National Invitation Tournament update.** The oversight committee received an update on the 2026 NIT. Specifically, the oversight committee received an update on the selection procedures for the 32-team field.
6. **Update on Playing Rules Subcommittee review of placement of logos on student-athlete uniforms and use of logos on courts for all contests except NCAA championships.** The oversight committee received an update on the Playing Rules Subcommittee's review of placement of logos on student-athlete uniforms and adopted the subcommittee's recommendation to:
 - Continue to permit no more than two commercial logos on the playing court:
 - The logo(s) shall fit into a box that is 10 feet by 10 feet square.
 - The box shall be located 8½ feet from the division line and 4½ feet from the sideline.
 - Logo(s) shall be within the two 10-foot-by-10-foot squares, with not more than one square in each half of the playing court.
 - Continue to permit commercial advertising outside each sideline.
 - Permit commercial advertising in the space beyond each end line.

The committee noted the importance of compliance with playing rules and will continue discussions specific to monitoring and enforcement of rules at future meetings.

7. **Review of NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Committee December 11 and December 17, 2025, and January 21, February 2 and February 17-19, 2026, Selection Orientation meeting reports.** The oversight committee received an update from the men's basketball committee's recent meetings. Specifically, the oversight committee received an update about player availability reporting for the 2026 NCAA Division I men's basketball championship and associated education to the membership. Additionally, it was noted that the men's basketball committee conducted a media mock selection on February 19, 2026.
8. **Men's basketball administration update.** Due to time constraints, the oversight committee will review this agenda item at its next meeting on April 21.
