



**REPORT OF THE NCAA  
DIVISION I MEN'S BASKETBALL OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE  
FEBRUARY 6, 2026, VIDEOCONFERENCE**

**ACTION ITEMS.**

**INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.**

1. **NCAA legal update.** The NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Oversight Committee received a legal update on several items impacting Division I men's basketball.
2. **Men's basketball player availability education.** The oversight committee received an informational update on player availability reporting for the 2026 NCAA Division I men's basketball championship. An overview was provided with the purpose, core principles, and timing of the report submissions and duties and responsibilities. This initiative for both men's and women's basketball championships is designed to protect student-athlete well-being and competitive integrity from sports betting influences.
3. **Sports betting update.** The oversight committee received an informational update on sports betting. Specifically, the oversight committee was provided with an overview of recent federal cases and other NCAA enforcement matters involving sports wagering.
4. **NCAA Division I legislative update.** The oversight committee received an update on adopted and proposed legislative changes in men's basketball. Specifically, the oversight committee was provided with a question-and-answer document associated with the recently adopted notification of transfer window legislation. Additionally, the oversight committee was provided with the six legislative proposals it introduced into the April 2026 legislative cycle during its January 6 meeting and January 9 joint Men's and Women's Basketball Oversight Committees' meeting. No membership feedback was received on the proposals, and the committee did not make any modifications to the proposals. Pending membership feedback and additional committee review, the oversight committee is anticipated to take action to adopt the proposals during its February 26 meeting and the February 27 joint Men's and Women's Basketball Oversight Committees' meeting.
5. **Outside competition discussion.** The oversight committee conducted an initial discussion on outside competition rules in basketball. Specifically, the oversight committee reviewed previous recommendations made by the oversight committee's College Basketball Summer Basketball Initiative Working Group and Outside Competition Working Group. The committee agreed to continue its discussion on outside competition rules in basketball during its next meeting on February 26.
6. **NCAA playing rules and statistics update.** The oversight committee received an update on playing rules and statistics during the 2025-26 men's basketball regular season. Specifically, the oversight committee was informed that game length continues to average two hours and one minute. Additionally, scoring is up 2.27 points per game; the sport is at pace to break all-time records for three-point attempts, three-pointers made and free throw

percentage. Due to time constraints, the oversight committee will receive updates specific to the placement of additional corporate logos on courts and uniforms during the regular season at its next meeting on February 26.

7. **Men's basketball administration update.** Due to time constraints, the oversight committee will review this agenda item at its next meeting on February 26.
8. **National Association of Basketball Coaches update.** Due to time constraints, the oversight committee will review this agenda item at its next meeting on February 26.
9. **Identification of discussion topics for the upcoming NCAA Division I Men's and Women's Basketball Oversight Committees' joint meeting.** The oversight committee identified two topics to discuss at its next joint meeting on February 27: (1) Division I basketball student-athlete eligibility; and (2) outside competition rules in basketball.
