



**REPORT OF THE NCAA
DIVISION I MEN'S BASKETBALL OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE
JULY 31, 2023, VIDEOCONFERENCE**

ACTION ITEMS.

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

1. **Transfer windows discussion.** The NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Oversight Committee (MBOC) discussed the June 27-28 NCAA Division I Council action to introduce a legislative proposal that would reduce the duration of the transfer windows in all sports from 60 days to 30 days and considered potential models for timing and duration of the transfer windows in men's basketball. The MBOC also received updates from NCAA Division I Student-Athlete Advisory Committee and the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Student-Athlete Engagement Group (SAEG) on their current positions on transfer windows. The committee discussed multiple options for modifying the men's basketball transfer window and agreed to seek feedback from the National Association of Basketball Coaches and additional feedback from the SAEG on two options:
 - a. Men's basketball transfer window begins the Monday after the NCAA men's Elite Eight and extends for 30 days; or
 - b. Men's basketball transfer window begins the day following a team's last contest and extends for 30 days.
 - (1) For teams not participating in any postseason tournament (e.g., NCAA Division I championship, National Invitation Tournament), the transfer window begins the Monday following Selection Sunday and extend for 30 days.
 - (2) For teams participating in any postseason tournament, the transfer window begins the day following the team's last contest and extend for 30 days.
2. **Review of postgraduate transfer eligibility requirements and NCAA Division I Committee for Legislative Relief Previously Approved Waiver criteria.** The committee reviewed the current application of the transfer process for postgraduate transfers (including the current previously approved waiver criteria for postgraduate transfer participation) and discussed whether the legislative notification of transfer deadlines referenced in the one-time transfer exception should extend to postgraduate transfers seeking to establish their eligibility through the waiver process. While the committee noted initial support for ensuring the legislative notification of transfer deadlines be maintained within the waiver environment, they also discussed whether graduate transfers should be required to enter the NCAA Transfer Portal during a specific window in order for those student-athletes to utilize the postgraduate transfer participation waiver.

3. **Follow-up on NCAA Division I Legislative Committee Modernization of Rules Subcommittee (MRS) agents and amateurism discussion.** The committee received an update on the previously discussed modernization areas of focus for deregulation, including pre- and post-enrollment professional opportunities, use of agents and professional drafts. The committee agreed to have the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Oversight Committee Legislative Subcommittee review the MRS recommendations on agents and amateurism during an upcoming call.
4. **NCAA College Basketball Academy update.** The committee received an initial update on the NCAA College Basketball Academy. The committee will receive a thorough update on survey data and measurables collected from the Academy during a future meeting.
5. **NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Student-Athlete Engagement Group update.** The committee received an update on the July 10 SAEG videoconference. The committee noted the SAEG will continue to discuss potential transfer window modifications and summer playing opportunities during its upcoming call in August.
6. **NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Committee update.** The committee received an update on the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Committee's summer meeting. Highlights from the meeting included an initial discussion on possible tournament expansion, adjustments to the NCAA Evaluation Tool (NET) principles and procedures and a recap of the 2023 championship.
7. **Senior minority administrator (SMA) update.** The committee received an update on the NCAA Minority Opportunities and Interests Committee's (MOIC) review of the oversight committee's recommendation on the creation of a SMA position. The MOIC will continue to discuss the development of a working group which will examine the SMA during its September 2023 meeting.
8. **NABC update.** The committee received an update on the NABC's recruiting calendar concept, which it plans to recommend to the MBOC for consideration of a legislative proposal in October 2023 with a anticipate effective date of January 2024. Additionally, the committee received an update on the Canada Global Jam and the upcoming Basketball Hall of Fame ceremony.
9. **Preview of August MBOC Legislative Subcommittee agenda.** The committee received a preview of the Legislative Subcommittee's August agenda. The committee noted that the subcommittee's agenda includes a review of proposals that are scheduled to be voted on by the Council during its October meeting.
10. **Identification of discussion topics for NCAA Division I Men's and Women's Basketball Oversight Committees' August 29 joint videoconference agenda.** The committee was

asked to identify any topics to be discussed during an upcoming joint Men’s and Women’s Basketball Oversight Committees’ videoconference.

11. **NCAA Division I Men’s Basketball Oversight Committee June 26-27 in-person meeting and the July 19 NCAA Division I Men’s Basketball Oversight Committee Administrative Subcommittee videoconference reports.** The committee reviewed and approved its June 26-27 in-person meeting and the July 19 Administrative Subcommittee videoconference reports.
