



**REPORT OF THE NCAA
DIVISION I MEN'S BASKETBALL OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE
JULY 16, 2020, VIDEOCONFERENCE**

ACTION ITEMS.

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

1. **Summer access start date.** Due to the continuing impact of the COVID-19 pandemic, the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Oversight Committee considered whether to recommend postponing the first permissible date of men's basketball summer access activities currently scheduled to begin Monday, July 20. The committee agreed the original date should be maintained, noting individual institutions and/or conferences are in the best position to determine when summer access activities for their student-athletes should occur within applicable state and local regulations.
2. **NBA Pre-Draft process.** The committee received an update from the June 30 NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Oversight Committee Administrative Subcommittee videoconference regarding a student-athlete's ability to enter the NBA Draft under the NBA's updated early-entry deadline. Further, the committee discussed whether to adjust the NCAA's August 3 deadline to withdrawal from the 2020 NBA Draft to allow NBA Draft Combine invitees to participate in the combine. Prior to making a recommendation to the NCAA Division I Council Coordination Committee, the oversight committee requested the NCAA staff seek feedback from the National Association of Basketball Coaches Ad-Hoc Committee on the NBA. The oversight committee plans to review the NABC feedback and make a determination on the NCAA withdrawal date for combine invitees during its July Administrative Subcommittee meeting.
3. **Review of the 2020 September recruiting calendar.** In response to a request by the Division I Council, the committee discussed the September 2020 recruiting calendar. Based on the continuing impact of COVID-19, the committee recommended the current temporary recruiting dead period be extended through the end of September. It noted the challenges of beginning any on- or off-campus recruiting activities during a time when large numbers of students and student-athletes will be returning to campus.
4. **Review of the 2020-2021 NCAA Division I men's basketball playing and practice season.** The committee received an update from the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Committee discussion regarding options for the 2020-2021 NCAA Division I men's basketball playing and practice season. The committee noted the challenges impacting institutions and conferences if a potential two-week shift of the first men's basketball contest (game or scrimmage) with outside competition was scheduled prior to the Tuesday immediately before the second Friday of November. Further, the committee discussed the complexity surrounding the timing for decisions regarding the start of the men's basketball regular season and the importance of health and safety protocols institutions and

conferences may implement leading up to and during the men's basketball season. The committee will continue to monitor outcomes associated with fall and winter sport participation and NCAA championships.

5. **Discussion regarding social justice.** The committee appointed one of its members to lead a new working group focused on developing and supporting racial equality initiatives. The committee received an update on the work of various committees within the association regarding possible initiatives identified by the oversight committee during their June meeting.
6. **Review of NCAA Enforcement Certification and Approvals Group Policies and Procedures.** The committee reviewed and approved the annual NCAA Enforcement Certification and Approvals Group Policies and Procedures for certification of nonscholastic men's basketball events.
7. **NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Committee update.** The oversight committee received an update from the Men's Basketball Committee regarding the 2021 NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Tournament and the flexibility available to conferences to determine their automatic qualifiers given the uncertainty of COVID-19. The oversight committee also received an update on various levels of contingency plans to safely operate the 2021 Men's Basketball Tournament including the potential to reduce seating capacity by 75-50-25% at all or specified sites or permitting only essential personnel. The Men's Basketball Committee will meet monthly to discuss the administration of the tournament and provide regular updates to the oversight committee.
8. **NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Oversight Committee Transfer Working Group update.** The committee received an update from the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Oversight Committee Transfer Working Group. The working group continues to examine issues surrounding tampering, NCAA Division I Academic Progress Rate, roster management, academic benchmarks, notification of transfer date and education regarding entering the NCAA Transfer Portal to provide input to the NCAA Division I Working Group on Transfers.
9. **Approval of reports.** The Men's Basketball Oversight Committee approved its June 15 report and June 4 and June 30 Administrative Subcommittee reports. Further, the committee approved the June 16 and July 2 Men's Basketball Oversight Committee Transfer Working Group reports and the June 2 Men's and Women's Basketball Oversight Committees Basketball Committees Composition Working Group report.
