

# ADDENDUM REPORT OF THE NCAA DIVISION I MEN'S BASKETBALL OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE JUNE 24-25, 2024, MEETING

# INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

- 1. Transfer window update and the Division I Progress-Toward-Degree Waiver Directive for 2024-25. The NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Oversight Committee received an update specific to the upcoming NCAA Division I Council discussion on recommendations for a 30-day transfer window. The committee also received an update on NCAA Transfer Portal data from the 2023-24 window in men's basketball and an update from the NCAA Division I Committee on Academics on updates to the progress-toward-degree directive that will be used to evaluate waivers submitted for academic deficiencies impacting student-athlete eligibility during the 2024-25 academic year.
- 2. Discuss NCAA Division I Legislative Committee review of the National Association of Basketball Coaches 4-4-4 transfer and financial aid recommendation. The committee received an update on the Division I Legislative Committee's recommendation to issue two blanket waivers pertaining to specific financial aid provisions that apply to undergraduate four-year transfer student-athletes. The first blanket waiver would permit the future aid to be exempted after an undergraduate four-year transfer student-athlete re-enters the NCAA Transfer Portal, provided that if the student-athlete ultimately remains and does not transfer again, they are no longer participating on the team. The blanket waiver is effective for the 2024-25 and 2025-26 academic years and does not release an institution from its obligation to honor the student-athlete's athletics scholarship if the student-athlete remains enrolled, it simply permits the aid to be exempted from team limits.
- 3. NABC update. The committee received an update from the NABC related to continued discussions on the current landscape of college athletics and how the NABC can best support and provide feedback to the oversight committee on making positive changes to men's basketball via the legislative pilot process.
- 4. NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Student-Athlete Engagement Group update. The committee received an update on the solicitation of nominations for the 2024-25 Men's Basketball Student-Athlete Engagement Group. The SAEG will have its first teleconference of the 2024-25 academic year in early to mid-August.
- 5. National Invitation Tournament update. The committee received an update on the 2024 NIT which included a 19% increase in year-over-year attendance, a 280% increase in championship game viewership and a record 1.4 million viewers for the championship game. The committee also received an update on the initial plans for the 2025 NIT and selection considerations.

- 6. Men's basketball stakeholders' May 14 meeting update. The committee received an update from the latest basketball stakeholders' meeting between the NCAA, NBA and USA Basketball. The primary focus of the meeting was specific to the state of basketball development in the United States and the commercialization of youth basketball in America versus internationally. The committee will continue to receive quarterly updates from future basketball stakeholders' meetings.
- 7. NCAA College Basketball Academy update. The committee received its final update on the operations, logistics, and schedule for the upcoming 2024 NCAA College Basketball Academy.
- 8. 2024-25 NCAA Division I Council-governance pilot legislative process resources. The committee received an update that the standard Council-Governance Legislative Pilot Process has been approved for continuation through the 2024-25 academic year. The process will follow the same format and timeline as the pilot process last year. Additionally, the committee was provided an update on the new recruiting calendar policy pilot adopted for 2024-25 allowing the men's basketball recruiting calendar to be managed and approved by the oversight committee.
- 9. NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Oversight Committee, NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Committee and NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Committee nominees. The oversight committee reviewed and discussed nominations for one administrator and one head coach opening for the Men's Basketball Oversight Committee. The oversight committee voted to resolicit nominees for its head coach vacancy and moved its recommendations for its administrator vacancy. The oversight committee also discussed and moved its nominations for one head coach, one administrator and two public member openings for the Men's Basketball Competition Committee. Finally, the oversight committee also moved its recommendations for the Men's Basketball Committee vacancies. These nominations will be forwarded to the NCAA Division I Council Coordination Committee for its review.
- 10. Identification of discussion topics for upcoming NCAA Division I Men's and Women's Basketball Oversight Committees' joint meeting agenda. The committee was asked to identify any topics to be discussed during an upcoming joint Men's and Women's Basketball Oversight Committees' meeting.
- 11. NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Oversight Committee May 16, 2024, videoconference report. The committee reviewed and approved its May 16 videoconference report.
