



**REPORT OF THE NCAA
DIVISION I MEN'S BASKETBALL OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE
MAY 15, 2023, VIDEOCONFERENCE**

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

1. **Championships media consultant – presentation by Endeavor on the media landscape.** The NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Oversight Committee received an update on the current media landscape and media rights consultation from Endeavor. The final report is to be provided by Endeavor to the NCAA by July 1, 2023. This will include Endeavor's recommended strategy for taking the NCAA championship media rights to market later this year.
2. **2023 College Basketball Summer Initiative draft concept.** The committee received an update from the Men's and Women's College Basketball Summer Initiative Working Groups most recent meetings and the survey that was sent to the Division I conference membership on May 3, 2023. Feedback gathered by Division I conferences will be due back to the NCAA by June 9, 2023. The feedback on the draft concepts will be reviewed in June 2023 by the men's and women's working groups for consideration to amend the concepts prior to a formal recommendation being made to the Division I Men's and Women's Basketball Oversight Committees and the NCAA Division I Council.
3. **Summer basketball recruiting calendar refresher.** The committee received an update on the 2023 men's basketball summer recruiting calendar that included a reminder of upcoming evaluation periods in June and July.
4. **NCAA College Basketball Academy update.** The committee received an update on the 2023 NCAA College Basketball Academy including further information related to the U.S. Open pathway and life skills sessions.
5. **NCAA Regional Rules Seminar Basketball Hot Topics overview.** The committee received an update on the agenda items and information that will be shared related to the Basketball Hot Topics session at the upcoming NCAA Regional Rules Seminar.
6. **Update from NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Committee May 3-4 meeting and May 4 joint meeting with the National Association of Basketball Coaches Board of Directors.** The oversight committee received an update from the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Committee spring meeting and the joint meeting that was conducted in conjunction with the NABC Board of Directors. The Men's Basketball Committee discussed topics including reports on broadcast, media, ticketing, misconducts, honorariums, merchandise sales and a review of the final NET rankings. The Men's Basketball Committee also had initial discussions about the 2024 championship.

7. **NCAA Men's Basketball Rules Committee May 3-5 meeting update.** The oversight committee received an update from the Men's Basketball Rules Committee. The rules committee approved 11 proposed rules changes this year, most notably: flexibility within rules specific to uniforms (design, numbers, colors), a change to the legal guarding position rule, the adoption of a peacekeeper rule (i.e., must be any nonplayer, adult personnel may come onto the floor to diffuse any potential fight/altercation), and now permitting officials to review goaltending/basket interference calls. These proposed rules changes will be reviewed by the NCAA Playing Rules Oversight Panel for final approval June 8, 2023. Further, the rules committee recommended two experimental rules changes to the 2024 National Invitation Tournament such as a widening of the lane to 16 feet, which is utilized in the NBA, and the standard media timeout format which was experimented with last season. These experimental rules changes will be reviewed during the NIT Board's annual meeting in June 2023.
8. **NBA pre-draft process update.** The committee received an update on the 2023 NBA pre-draft process, including a review of key dates and information related to the number of Undergraduate Advisory Committee evaluation requests, NBA Draft early entrants, and G League Elite camp and NBA Draft Combine invitees. It was noted that the number of NCAA men's basketball student-athletes entering the NBA Draft as early entrants declined in comparison to last year. After the conclusion of the 2023 NBA Draft, more complete pre-draft process data and trends will be shared with the committee.
9. **NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Student-Athlete Engagement Group update.** The committee received an update on the newly formed Student-Athlete Engagement Group. The group will hold its first videoconference within the next month and serve as a men's basketball student-athlete-specific group that will engage and provide feedback on current basketball related topics as well as receive specialized programming from NCAA staff and outside basketball stakeholders throughout the year.
10. **Identification of discussion topics for upcoming NCAA Division I Men's and Women's Basketball Oversight Committees' joint meeting.** The committee was asked to identify any topics to be discussed during an upcoming joint Men's and Women's Basketball Oversight Committees' meeting.
11. **NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Oversight Committee April 17 videoconference report.** The committee reviewed and approved its April 17 videoconference report.
