



**REPORT OF THE NCAA DIVISION I
MEN'S AND WOMEN'S BASKETBALL OVERSIGHT COMMITTEES'
NOVEMBER 16, 2020, JOINT VIDEOCONFERENCE**

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

1. **NCAA Division I Men's and Women's Basketball Oversight Committees' October 23 joint videoconference report.** The oversight committees reviewed and approved the October 23 joint videoconference report.
2. **Request to permit an institution to exempt for future years the athletics aid of a student-athlete who received a COVID-19 eligibility extension to use the last season of eligibility while remaining enrolled at the same institution.** The oversight committees received an update on a recommendation from the Southeastern Conference to extend the previous NCAA Division I Council action to allow an institution to exempt the athletics aid during a student-athlete's final year of eligibility for an individual who has received a COVID-19 eligibility extension waiver provided the student-athlete has remained enrolled at the same institution. The oversight committees discussed the benefits such a concept could provide to a student-athlete and to his or her team, but recognized the potential challenges, as intercollegiate athletics continues to be impacted by the pandemic. The oversight committees agreed to table this concept, noting that additional information and consideration was necessary before making a final decision, including the progress of the upcoming season.
3. **Blanket waiver for countable athletically related activities following competition for the 2020-21 academic year.** The oversight committees expressed support for a blanket waiver under the following conditions: (1) Up to one hour of film and/or team meetings may be conducted following competition when the team is competing the next day; (2) Time spent in film review and/or team meetings must be included in the daily and weekly hour limitations; and (3) Support from institution's legal/medical/risk advisors is required before engaging in film review and/or team meetings following competition. The oversight committees' feedback will be shared with the NCAA Division I Committee on Legislative Relief
4. **Other business.** The oversight committees received an update on the relocation of the 13 predetermined preliminary round sites for the 2021 NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Championship.
