



**REPORT OF THE NCAA  
DIVISION I MEN'S BASKETBALL OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE  
NOVEMBER 18, 2021, VIDEOCONFERENCE**

**INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.**

1. **Men's basketball transfer update.** The NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Oversight Committee received a presentation from the NCAA staff regarding the NCAA Transfer Portal, 2020-21 men's basketball transfer data and legislative relief waivers involving 4-4 transfers. The committee requested another men's basketball transfer update from the NCAA staff during its January 2022 meeting once the NCAA research staff has final data from last year's transfers. Finally, the committee noted it would be helpful to receive data from the NCAA staff in the future regarding the number of men's basketball student-athletes who enter their name into the Transfer Portal and then end up matriculating at a two-year institution or an National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics institution and those who do not end up matriculating at any collegiate institution.
2. **Review of July 2022 men's basketball recruiting calendar.** The committee received a brief update regarding the impact of the 2022 NCAA College Basketball Academy postponement on the July 2022 men's basketball recruiting calendar. The July 2022 recruiting calendar modification recommendation from the National Association of Basketball Coaches will be presented in writing to the committee for its consideration during its January 18 meeting, with anticipated action by the NCAA Division I Council during the Council's January 19 meeting.
3. **2021-22 NCAA Division I men's basketball start of season update.** The committee received an update from the NCAA staff regarding the start of the 2021-22 men's basketball season. The committee noted excitement surrounding the return of fans at men's basketball games this season. Additionally, the staff noted there have only been two games postponed this season due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
4. **NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Committee update.** The oversight committee received an update from the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Committee. The oversight committee discussed the differing COVID-19 guidelines and procedures that are in place at various facilities across the country for men's basketball games. Additionally, the oversight committee noted the 2022 NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Championship selection process will remain the same as in past years. The oversight committee noted the 2022 NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Championship bracket preview show will occur on February 19 at 12:30 p.m. EST on CBS. Finally, the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball and Women's Basketball Committees will meet jointly on December 10 and the basketball committees plan to discuss a combined Final Four during their joint meeting.
5. **NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Competition Committee update.** The oversight committee received an update from the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Competition Committee. The oversight committee approved the Men's Basketball Competition Committee's November 3 report and noted the competition committee is continuing to

discuss playing rules regarding the shot clock, flopping, traveling, the number of fouls permitted and advancing the ball at the end of the game. The oversight committee also received an update on the virtual preseason officiating clinics that were held prior to the start of the 2021-22 men's basketball season.

6. **Men's Basketball Oversight Committee October 25 videoconference report.** The committee reviewed and approved the report from its October 25 videoconference.
