NCAA DIVISION I MEN'S BASKETBALL OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE
ADMINISTRATIVE SUBCOMMITTEE
NOVEMBER 18, 2022, VIDEOCONFERENCE**

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

1. **Review and approval of the 2027-2030 Final Four sites.** The NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Oversight Committee Administrative Subcommittee reviewed and approved the 2027-2030 NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Championship Final Four sites. The 2027-2030 NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Championship Final Four sites will be announced publicly on Tuesday, November 22.

2. **Review National Association of Basketball Coaches' recommendation for NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Oversight Committee's areas of authority.** During its November 2 meeting, the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Oversight Committee reviewed the NABC's recommendation for men's basketball legislative and policy autonomy and discussed the list of NABC recommended areas of authority. The subcommittee agreed with the recommended areas of authority including the following:
 - Athletics aid and institutional benefits.
 - Benefits and compensation from noninstitutional sources.
 - Budgetary authority to invest in men's basketball growth opportunities.
 - Athletics eligibility.
 - Recruiting.
 - Playing and practice seasons.
 - Rules for competition and participation.
 - Championship opportunities and operations.
 - Roster and staff composition.

The subcommittee also noted the importance of maintaining separate oversight committees for men's and women's basketball in the new NCAA governance model. The subcommittee noted the current structure of separate oversight committees for men's and women's basketball is effective. The separate oversight committees have been responsive to individual cultural and structural differences across genders and the oversight committees have been coordinated and aligned when issues are similar and impact both genders. The current structure allows for the separate oversight committees to be successful in managing issues and making decisions that are in the best interest of each sport, while also successfully communicating and collaborating on joint issues that impact the sport at large.

3. **Review College Commissioners Association (CCA) NCAA College Basketball Academies letter.** The subcommittee discussed a letter from the CCA to NCAA staff seeking to pause the 2023 NCAA College Basketball Academies.
