



**REPORT OF THE NCAA DIVISION I
MEN'S AND WOMEN'S BASKETBALL OVERSIGHT COMMITTEES
OCTOBER 29, 2020, JOINT VIDEOCONFERENCE**

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

1. **NCAA Division I Men's and Women's Basketball Oversight Committees' October 23 joint videoconference report.** The oversight committees reviewed and approved the October 23 joint videoconference report.
2. **NCAA Medical Advisory Panel update on basketball.** The oversight committees received an update regarding testing frequency and issues related to quarantine protocol.
3. **NCAA Men's and Women's Basketball Officiating COVID-19 update.** The oversight committees received updates regarding officiating changes during the COVID-19 pandemic. These changes include the creation of plans for officiating that extend beyond the game day operations document, an officiating dashboard for tracking officials COVID-19 test results, two-person officiating mechanics and advancing the current safety practices document. These recommendations will be reviewed by the Medical Advisory Panel on November 3 and released to the membership shortly thereafter. The oversight committees will continue to receive officiating updates throughout the 2020-21 playing season.
4. **NCAA Men's and Women's Basketball Playing Rules COVID-19 update.** The oversight committees received updates from the Men's and Women's Basketball Rules Committees, including waivers and interpretations for the 2020-21 season related to the COVID-19 pandemic. During its next meeting, the Men's Basketball Rules Committee will continue to discuss a concept that would allow one official to complete a game under certain circumstances (e.g., amount of time remaining, score of the contest) and parameters for artificial crowd noise, including a review of the procedures used by the NBA.

The oversight committees also received an update from the NCAA Division I Council's discussion on remote coaching concept. Specifically, the Council referred to the basketball rules committees' further exploration of options that would permit coaches to coach remotely within the arena during the COVID-19 pandemic. Both the men's and women's basketball rules committees did not support the concept, noting continued concerns regarding the inequities that would be presented, difficulties in establishing an equitable way to implement this concept and the fundamental alteration of the manner in which the game is coached.

5. **Identification of other 2020-21 basketball playing season issues.** The oversight committees did not note any additional playing season issues beyond those currently under review.

6. **Other business.** The oversight committees received an update on the recent cancellation of the planned multiple-team events.
