



**REPORT OF THE
NCAA DIVISION I COMMITTEE ON STUDENT-ATHLETE REINSTATEMENT
DECEMBER 9, 2022, MEETING**

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

1. **Discussion of sports-wagering issues, legislation and guidelines.** The NCAA Division I Committee on Student-Athlete Reinstatement discussed the current landscape surrounding sports wagering as it relates to reinstatement cases and the current NCAA legislation and committee guidelines. The committee instructed NCAA student-athlete reinstatement staff to continue reviewing cases on a case-by-case basis, noting staff should continue evaluating mitigation presented and acknowledging the evolving landscape specific to sports wagering.
2. **Update on outside competition violations and decisions.** The committee reviewed outside competition violations decided by staff since its May 2022 meeting. The committee agreed staff appropriately applied flexibility, including increased rules education as a condition of reinstatement for outside competition violations. The committee directed staff to continue reviewing outside competition violations in the same manner, noting the increased legislative requirements specific to men's basketball summer leagues may continue to result in withholding from competition. As part of its discussion, the committee reviewed 16 cases and determined they should be published to NCAA Requests/Self-Reports Online (RSRO).
3. **Discussion of violations involving impermissible use of, or benefits from, agents.** The committee discussed the current landscape surrounding agent interactions with pre- and post-enrollment student-athletes. The committee instructed staff to continue reviewing each case on a case-by-case basis and will continue discussions on this topic at its next meeting.
4. **Review Division I Committee on Student-Athlete Reinstatement May 2022 report.** The committee reviewed and approved the report from its May 2022 in-person meeting.
5. **Review of community service conditions guideline.** The committee reviewed and affirmed its community service guideline.
6. **Review of reinstatement guidelines.** The committee reviewed and approved editorial revisions to the NCAA Division I Committee on Student-Athlete Reinstatement Guidelines.
7. **Governance update.** The committee received a governance update from NCAA director of Division I governance.
8. **Litigation update.** The committee received a litigation update from NCAA senior counsel of external and membership affairs.
9. **Review NCAA Conflict of Interest Policy.** The committee reviewed the NCAA Conflict of Interest Policy.
