- Previously approved waivers and reinstatement requests. The NCAA Division I Committee on Student-Athlete Reinstatement approved the addition of NCAA Division I Bylaw 12.8.6 (season-of-competition waiver competition while eligible) for season-of-competition waivers related to COVID-19. Specifically, the committee determined when all the following are satisfied, an institution may self- apply a season-of-competition waiver competition while eligible for the 2019-20 academic year:
  - Student-athlete was academically and athletically eligible to compete at non-NCAA institution during spring 2020;
  - O Student-athlete triggered use of a season in a sport that is considered to be a spring sport by NCAA legislation; and
  - o Spring 2020 season was cancelled due to COVID-19.
