student-athlete survey while also discussing perceived challenges. In addition to the student-athlete survey, NCAA research staff gave an update on recent NCAA surveys including the health and wellness survey. The committee engaged in a conversation following the presentation, discussing and highlighting themes within the surveys.

Additionally, the committee discussed the duties and expectations for members serving on Council standing and Association-wide committees.
